TCEQ Updates

• TCEQ's 2022 Environmental Trade Fair & Conference, May 10-11, 2022, Austin Convention Center **TCEQ Rulemaking Activities as 01/25/2022**

1. HB 4472: TERP Amendments. 87th Texas Legislature, 2021, requires the commission to amend 30 Texas Administrative Code §114.622(b), to set the minimum percentage of annual hours of operation required for Texas Emission Reduction Program (TERP)-funded marine vessels or engines at 55% under the Diesel Emissions Reduction Incentive Program (DERIP). Existing statute requires that, over the lifetime of a project, the marine vessels or engines must be operated in the intercoastal waterways or bays adjacent to a nonattainment area or affected county of this state by the percentage established by the commission

2. Compliance History Rules Update is rulemaking revises Chapter 60, Compliance History, by adding new §60.4. This new section would establish a provision allowing the Executive Director to reclassify a site's compliance history classification. Several large emergency incidents at industrial facilities in the past few years have caused significant impacts to public health and the environment, which have resulted in scrutiny of the compliance histories of the regulated entities involved in these incidents. The executive director is requesting authority to make designation to and reclassify a site's compliance history classification under 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 60 in a manner different than the rules currently allow for a site involved in an emergency event that causes or results in exigent circumstances.

3. HB 1284: Injection and Geologic Storage of Carbon Dioxide. This rulemaking would implement HB 1284, 87th Texas Legislature, which requires an amendment to the regulation of the injection and geologic storage, both onshore and offshore, of anthropogenic carbon dioxide (CO2) in this state,

EPA Updates

• January - National Radon Action Month (NRAM). <u>Radon</u> is a naturally occurring radioactive gas that that can enter homes from the ground and build up to dangerous levels.



- Awarded \$1,965,000 to TCEQ to help identify sources of lead in drinking water in schools or child care facilities. The funding will help protect children and helps advance the federal action plan to reduce childhood lead exposures. This award brings TCEQ's total funding under the program to \$5,296,000.
- Recognized the Harris-Galveston Subsidence District as among 34 WaterSense partners that excelled at helping consumers and businesses save water during 2020. Award winners include utilities, manufacturers, builders, a retailer, and other organizations that promote WaterSense labeled products, build WaterSense labeled homes, and operate WaterSense labeled certification programs. The district reached 40,000 3rd-6th grade Houston-area students through its Water Detectives program, and transitioned many other programs to a virtual format to continue reaching students, parents and teachers throughout the pandemic.

violation alleged int he agreed order. 2) A statement that the agreed administrative order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the Office of the Attorney General to: (a) enforce the terms of the order; or (b) pursue violations of the Water Code or Health and Safety Code.

Regulated Entity: The entity (company, governmental body, person, etc.) located at the specific site where the violations occurred or, for a licensee, the person who caused the violations.

Respondent (customer): The party cited in an enforcement action who is responsible for correcting violations, possibly paying penalties, and complying with an issued enforcement order or compliance agreement.

Enforcement Action: The actions that the agency has taken in order to enforce rules, regulations, or statutes of the State. These actions can include *administrative orders, court orders, compliance agreements, or referrals* to other agencies or to other programs within the TCEQ, such as the Superfund program.

Enforcement Type: The type of enforcement action that the agency is seeking.
