#### I. TCEQ Rulemaking Activities as 09/27/2021

- Commission Approval for Proposed Rulemaking Chapter 60, Compliance History Site Classification Changes Due to Exigent Circumstances Rule Project No. 2020-049-060-CE
  - The purpose of this proposed rulemaking is to provide a more immediate and accurate measure of a site's performance following an exigent event. Without this rulemaking, if an exigent event occurs, an associated site's compliance history may not accurately account for the event.
  - Several large emergency incidents at industrial facilities in the past few years have caused significant impacts to public health and the environment, which have resulted in scrutiny of the compliance histories of the regulated entities involved in these incidents. The executive director is requesting authority to make designation to and reclassify a site's compliance history classification under 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 60 in a manner different than the rules currently allow for a site involved in an emergency event that causes or results in exigent circumstances.
  - This new section would provide a process for the executive director to designate a site's compliance history classification as "under review," and to reclassify it to "suspended" if the executive director determines that exigent circumstances exist due to an event at a site, such as a major explosion or fire, that significantly impacts the surrounding community and environment, causes emergency response efforts by federal or state authorities to address pollutants, contaminants, or other materials regulated by the agency, and results in certain urgent or grave consequences.
  - Regulated community: The proposed rulemaking may result in fiscal implications for businesses or individuals if they have a site that is involved in exigent circumstances which necessitates a federal or state emergency response and results in urgent consequences. The estimated fiscal impact resulting from this proposed rule would vary for each site that the executive director decides to designate as "under review" and reclassify as "suspended." Any costs will depend on the specific situations and if the applicant is prevented from obtaining an authorization.
    - Stakeholder meetings: No stakeholder meeting was held; however, a public hearing will be offered during the comment period in January 2022.
    - Potential controversial concerns and legislative interest: There is significant interest in this
      proposed rule from legislative members, environmental interest groups, and the regulated
      community.
    - Key points in the proposal rulemaking schedule: Anticipated proposal date: December 15, 2021 Anticipated Texas Register publication date: December 31, 2021 Anticipated public hearing date: January 27, 2022 Anticipated public comment period: December 31, 2021 February 1, 2022 Anticipated adoption date: June 1, 2022 (See <a href="https://www.tceq.texas.gov/assets/public/legal/rules/rule\_lib/proposals/20049060\_pex.pdf">https://www.tceq.texas.gov/assets/public/legal/rules/rule\_lib/proposals/20049060\_pex.pdf</a>)
- Approval for Proposed Rulemaking Chapter 331, Underground Injection Control HB 1284: Relating to the regulation of the injection and geologic storage of carbon dioxide in this state Rule Project No. 2021-025-331-WS
  - This rulemaking implements House Bill (HB) 1284, 87th Texas Legislature, Regular Session (RS), 2021, addressing statutory authority over regulation of injection and geologic sequestration and storage, both onshore and offshore, of anthropogenic carbon dioxide (CO2) in Texas. HB 1284 amends Chapter 27 of the Texas Water Code (TWC), §382 of the Texas Health and Safety Code (THSC), §121 of the Natural Resources Code, and §202 of the Tax Code. The Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) would have sole state jurisdiction



- over onshore and offshore injection and geologic storage of anthropogenic CO2 and would seek primacy from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for administration of the Class VI injection well program.
- Under HB 1284, the RRC would have sole state jurisdiction over onshore and offshore injection and geologic storage of anthropogenic CO2. The proposed rulemaking removes TCEQ jurisdiction over the injection of anthropogenic CO2 produced by a clean coal project into a zone that is below the base of usable quality water and that is not productive of oil, gas, or geothermal resources by removing 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §331.11(d).
- Key points in the proposal rulemaking schedule: Anticipated proposal date: December 15, 2021 Anticipated Texas Register publication date: December 31, 2021 Anticipated public hearing date: January 25, 2022 Anticipated public comment period: December 31, 2021 February 1, 2022 Anticipated adoption date: May 18, 2022 (See https://www.tceq.texas.gov/assets/public/legal/rules/rule lib/proposals/21025331 pex.pdf)
- 3. Maximum Achievable Control Technology (MACT) and Generally Available Control Technology (GACT) Standards Update (Rule Project No. 2022-005-113-AI)
  - (TCEQ or commission) administers federal regulations establishing National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) by incorporating these regulations by reference into Chapter 113, Subchapter C, of the Texas Administrative Code. The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has amended several MACT and GACT standards
  - Federal Clean Air Act (FCAA), the EPA is required to periodically conduct risk assessments on each source category and determine if changes are needed to reduce residual risks or address developments in applicable control technology.
  - amendments clarify and update work practice standards, compliance dates, recordkeeping, monitoring, reporting, and notification, including electronic notification.
  - TCEQ to incorporate the amended standards into Chapter 113, Subchapter C to avoid inconsistency between federal and state requirements; to allow the commission to enforce the most current MACT and GACT standards prior to receiving formal delegation of the amended standards; to facilitate delegation of the amended MACT standards from the EPA; and to maintain existing delegation.
  - Proposed schedule and constraints: Anticipated Proposal Date: June 29, 2022 Anticipated Public Comment Period: July 15, 2022-August 15, 2022 Anticipated Adoption Date: December 14, 2022
- 4. Approval for Rulemaking Adoption Chapter 335, Industrial Solid Waste and Municipal Hazardous Waste IHW Generator and Management Fees Increase Rule Project No. 2020-010-335-WS
  - Revisions to the industrial and hazardous waste (IHW) generator and management fee rules are needed to increase revenue into the Waste Management Account, Fund 0549. Fund 0549 is facing a declining fund balance and these fee rates have not been adjusted since 1994.
  - increase the IHW management fee schedule by 45% and to allow the executive director the ability to adjust the actual IHW management fee at or below the new fee schedule amounts. The executive director anticipates phasing in the fee increase over smaller increments and highlighting the declining Fund 549 balance during the 2023 Legislative Session. The executive director projects a 12% increase during the first year and 11% for the subsequent three years. The executive director will evaluate the fund balance and projected revenue each fiscal year to determine if these fee increases are necessary.



- may collect up to \$16 million per year for this fee. Based on current disposal amounts, a 45% increase phased in over four years will result in an estimated revenue close to, but below, the \$16 million cap.
- Key points in the adoption rulemaking schedule: Texas Register proposal publication date: June 4, 2021 Anticipated Texas Register adoption publication date: November 19, 2021 Anticipated effective date: November 25, 2021 Six-month Texas Register filing deadline: December 4, 2021
- 5. Approval for Rulemaking Adoption Chapter 311, Watershed Protection Sand Mining BMPs in the San Jacinto River Watershed Rule Project No. 2020-048-311-OW
  - The Texas Aggregates and Concrete Association (TACA) and the Lake Houston Area Grassroots Flood Prevention Initiative (FPI) filed separate petitions for rulemaking with TCEQ on June 15, 2020, and June 23, 2020, respectively (Non-Rule Project Numbers 2020-042-PET-NR and 2020-044-PET-NR).
  - Oboth organizations proposed that the TCEQ revise 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 311 rules to include a new subchapter that will require the executive director (ED) to establish a guidance document of best management practices (BMPs) for commercial sand mining and other lawful purposes within the San Jacinto River Watershed. The rulemaking adoption applies to sand mining facilities within the San Jacinto River Watershed. - 6. Approval for Rulemaking Adoption Chapter 332, Composting Clarifying Composting Notice Process and Obsolete Terms Rule Project No. 2021-006-332-WS
  - Revisions are necessary to clarify and update existing notice language and requirements found in 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §332.22(b).
  - Will provide clarity on the information an applicant must submit for a compost Notification of Intent (NOI). Currently, §332.22(b) uses the phrase "affected landowners" regarding who an applicant lists on its compost NOI, which creates ambiguity on which landowners should be listed. This rulemaking will also incorporate applicability, fees, and reporting requirements from 30 TAC Chapter 330, Subchapter P into sections for registered and permitted facilities. Various citations and other conflicting rules between multiple chapters will also be revised and clarified. Finally, broken and obsolete links, typos, misspellings, and grammar mistakes will be corrected throughout the rule to ensure clarity, readability, and the overall effectiveness of the rule.
  - The commission did not hold any stakeholder meetings related to this rulemaking; however, a rule public hearing was held during the comment period.

- Requires community water systems receive prompt notification of releases that are reportable under EPCRA, Section 304 - Register with ECHMA and local OEM(s)



- Community water systems are given access to hazardous chemical inventory data that is reported under EPCRA, Section 312. - Can go to TCEQ and request access to records in their jurisdiction.
- Unfunded mandate
- Requires facilities to notify the LEPC of any reportable releases of EPCRA EHSs and CERCLA HSs. (EPCRA Section 304(a)(1). Educate on LEPC process for reporting




Figure 1. U.S. EPA Toxic Release Inventory, Houston, TX 2020 (https://www.epa.gov/toxics-release-inventory-tri-program)

They can include administrative orders, court orders, compliance agreements, or referrals to other agencies or to other programs within the TCEQ, such as the Superfund program.

**Effective** means something different for each type of action.

**Administrative orders** are normally effective three days after the Chief Clerk's Office mails the order signed by the TCEQ Chairman or on the date of hand delivery of the signed document.

**Court orders** are effective on the date the judge signs the order.

**Compliance agreements** are effective on the date the agreement, signed by the Respondent, is received by the TCEQ.

**Referrals** are effective on the date of the letter or memorandum that refers the matter to the other agency or division.

occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of the agreed order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged int he agreed order. 2) A statement that the agreed administrative order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the Office of the Attorney General to: (a) enforce the terms of the order; or (b) pursue violations of the Water Code or Health and Safety Code.

**Regulated Entity:** The entity (company, governmental body, person, etc.) located at the specific site where the violations occurred or, for a licensee, the person who caused the violations.

**Respondent (customer):** The party cited in an enforcement action who is responsible for correcting violations, possibly paying penalties, and complying with an issued enforcement order or compliance agreement.

**Enforcement Action:** The actions that the agency has taken in order to enforce rules, regulations, or statutes of the State. These actions can include *administrative orders, court orders, compliance agreements, or referrals* to other agencies or to other programs within the TCEQ, such as the Superfund program.

**Enforcement Type:** The type of enforcement action that the agency is seeking.
