Two Built-In Tools That Can Replace Extra Software

1 SNIP WHAT YOU NEED

Windows + Shift + S

Capture exactly what's on your screen.



Select the area you want
Choose rectangular, window, full screen, or freeform.



Automatically copied
The screenshot is copied to your clipboard—ready to paste.



Paste anywhere
Drop it right into email, documents, chats, or presentations.



Need more?
Open Snipping Tool from your Start menu to annotate, save, or record your screen.

2 COPY MORE. PASTE SMARTER.

Windows + V

Access your clipboard history anytime.



Copy multiple items
Text, images, links—copy several things in a row.



Open Clipboard History
Press Windows + V to see a list of your most recent items.



Pin what you use often
Keep important items available even after new items are copied.



Clear when you're done
Keep your clipboard clean and secure, especially on shared PCs.



HOW THEY WORK TOGETHER



1. Snip it
Capture what you need.



2. Copy it
It's automatically copied.



3. Open it
Press Windows + V to view history.



4. Choose it
Pick the item you need.



5. Paste it
Paste into email, docs, chats & more.



SECURITY REMINDER

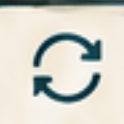
Clipboard history is convenient—use it wisely.

- Clear your clipboard history regularly.
- Be extra cautious on shared or public computers.



MORE BUILT-IN TOOLS

You might not know you have



Ctrl + Shift + T
Reopen the tab you accidentally closed.



Ctrl + L (or Cmd + L)
Jump to the address bar instantly.



F2
Rename a file quickly.



Print Screen
Capture your entire screen (or use Alt + Print Screen for the active window).
