

FIRE EXTINGUISHER SAFETY & USE

TYPES OF FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

- A: ORDINARY MATERIALS LIKE CLOTH, WOOD AND PAPER.**
- B: COMBUSTIBLE AND FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS LIKE GREASE, GASOLINE, OIL AND OIL BASED PAINTS**
- C: ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT LIKE APPLIANCES, TOOLS OR OTHER EQUIPMENT PLUGGED INTO AN OUTLET. CLASS C EXTINGUISHERS USE AN AGENT THAT DOESN'T CONDUCT ELECTRICITY.**
- D: FOR USE WITH FLAMMABLE METALS**
- K: FOR USE WITH VEGETABLE OILS, ANIMAL OILS AND FATS IN COOKING APPLIANCES.**

FIRE EVACUATION

- **BACK AWAY FROM AN EXTINGUISHED FIRE IN CASE IT FLAMES UP AGAIN.**
- **EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY IF THE EXTINGUISHER IS EMPTY AND THE FIRE IS NOT OUT.**
- **EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY IF THE FIRE PROGRESSES BEYOND THE INCIPIENT STAGE.**
- **MAKE SURE TO ALWAYS KNOW WHERE THE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE IN YOUR HOME OR PLACE OF WORK.**

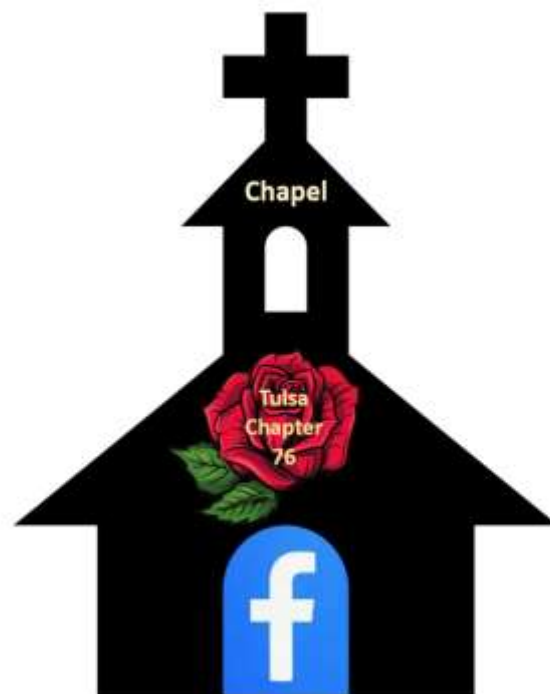

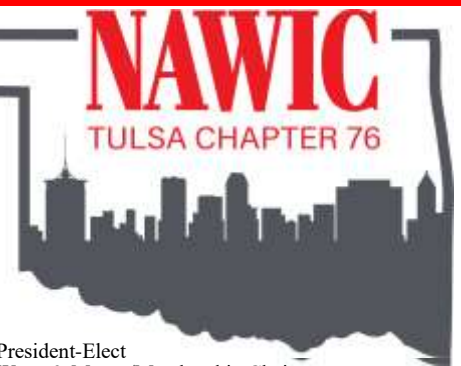
