If the Chapter 6 show at the 2022 Farm Science Review had to be described in a single word, that word would be “SUCCESSFUL”.

During August and early September, organizers were concerned about the lack of response from members regarding their willingness to commit to bring tractors, implements, and other IH related items to the show. The error by the printer that delayed the fall edition of the Binder further heightened their concerns because the appeal for show items failed to reach most members until just days prior to the opening.

As the time grew close and the need became known, the chapter members came through in a big way. Over a dozen display items were consigned in the final week before the show and a few even arrived on setup day without prior contact with the show folks.

There were a total of 43 individual items on display. They were presented by 24 members. The specific count was 30 tractors, two semi-trucks, two pickup trucks, two moldboard plows, two loaders, one truck with a feed mill,

one disc plow, one spreader, a modified F-30 pulling tractor, and a display of planter plates, check row equipment and a rare IH seed germination box.

In addition to selling a significant amount of merchandise through the trailer, the club signed up 20 new members.

The number of visitors through the display was many times greater than any previous year. The near perfect weather contributed to the overall attendance being significantly higher.

As part of the program guidelines the tractor will be raffled off December 9 and the proceeds will benefit the Dayton Children's Hospital Ronald McDonald House. This is the second tractor restored through this program.
