STEPS FOR SAFE FIREWORKS DISPOSAL

Soak- Completely submerge all combustibles, pyrotechnics, used and unused fireworks in water and allow to soak overnight.

Wrap- Double wrap the soaked fireworks in plastic wrap or plastic bags to retain moisture.

Dispose- Place wrapped bags in your regular household garbage and dispose of in your waste receptacle.

Do not recycle your fireworks. Although they are made out of paper, fireworks are not recyclable- ever.
