MAINTAINANCING YOUR TRASH RECEPTACLE

To prevent odors keep your garbage can clean by spraying it out with a garden hose periodically. Let it dry in the sun before placing trash inside.

Drain all garbage before throwing it in the bag.

Kill bad odors by dropping a couple of moth balls inside of your bag.

Prevent animal raids by keeping your trash can tightly closed.

Always avoid keeping trash out in the open, and always bag and tie up your discarded foods.

Set your garbage cans out as close to pick up time as possible.

TO REDUCE THE RISK FOR TRASH FIRES, DO NOT PLACE THE FOLLOWING IN YOUR TRASH:

- Flammable or combustible liquids (such as gasoline, oil-based paints, or kerosene)
- Hazardous materials (including ammonia, bleach, pool chemicals, pesticides, and paint thinners)
- Propellants, compressed gas, rechargeable batteries, and ashes from barbeque grills or fire pits
