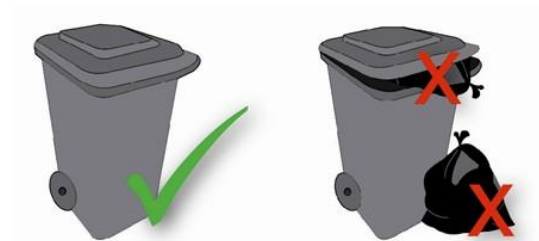

BOATING SAFETY: TIPS TO KEEP YOU SAFE THIS BOATING SEASON

Always Wear Your Life Jacket

Gear up to prepare for the unexpected by always wearing your life jacket every time you are on the water. The U.S. Coast Guard statistics tells us that 90% of fatal water accidents are the result of a missing life jacket. Be a role model and make life jackets a part of your boating gear.

Know the Nautical and Navigation Rules

Knowing the nautical rules of the road is very important for all boaters. Knowing what to do when crossing or meeting another boat can prevent costly damage to your boat, personal injury, or even loss of life. When in doubt always slow down, stop, or steer away from a potentially hazardous situation. Being alert and maintaining a safe speed are basic steps you can take to ensure the safety of yourself and others.

Be Aware of Carbon Monoxide

Be aware of the early symptoms (irritated eyes, headache, nausea, weakness, & dizziness), use CO detectors on your boat, and always stay off of the swim platform when the engine or generators are running.
