Transfer Station Re-opened Following Fire


Clean wood, unbagged leaves and branches are accepted at the old landfill site.

Spring News Tobling

Short Term Rental Bylaw

Bylaw #2025.02 passed in April and you must obtain a licence to operate short term rentals - also know as airbnbs. The fee is \$500 annually.

Short term rentals must be legal suites and comply with the *Construction Codes Act*, Building Code Regulations and Fire Safety Regulations.

Applications are available at the Village office or on our website under <u>Governance - Short Term Rentals</u>. Failure to obtain a license will result in a minimum fine of \$1000.



Business License Bylaw

Bylaw #2025.07 passed in April and is required for any person who does business within the Village, ie: food trucks, farmer's market, home based businesses, contractors, transient traders (offers goods, services or merchandise for sale or auction)

Excludes business activities which fall under other bylaws which have a licensing fee. ie: short term rentals, trailer parks or campgrounds and commercial businesses.

Applications are available at the Village office or on our website under <u>Governance - Business Licences</u>. Failure to obtain a license will result in a minimum fine of \$1000.



E-Notices



All invoices, receipts & tax notices will be sent via e-mail unless we are notified otherwise. This is to help reduce costs. If you wish to receive your notices via Canada Post, be sure to notify the office. With another postal strike looming, don't miss any invoices, receipts or tax notices and save on postage by using E-Notices.



Taxes

Tax notices will be sent out shortly, so keep an eye on your inbox!
