Garbage & Recycling

Over the holidays garbage and recycling will be picked up on Tuesday December 27th and Tuesday January 3rd. Bins are located down by the boat launch for your use as well. Please remember to recycle all household tin & aluminum, plastics #1-#7, mixed paper, cardboard and wrapping paper that is not foil. Please do not include foil bows or ribbons in your recycling. Along with bear sightings, we also have a racoon and some foxes in the village. Please remember to put your garbage in a bin with a secure lid and to keep the maximum weight below 55 lbs. Anything heavier will not be picked up.

Taxes and Lagoon Fee

Reminder that all Taxes and Lagoon Fees are due by December $31^{\rm st}$. A penalty of 1.876% will be applied to unpaid taxes each month proceeding and a penalty of 2% will be added on unpaid Lagoon fees which will compound monthly. 

- The 2021 Census was released & our population has increased by 56% now at 139 full time residents.
