**Water turn ons are now \$50**

**New infrastructure fee of \$200**

**Annual rate \$400**

**Seasonal rate \$150**

**Metered Rates:**

increased since 2015\****

**Commercial - \$1150.00 + \$10.00 per 1,000 gallons for usage over 100,000 gallons**

**Residential Annual - \$250.00 + \$10 per 1,000 gallons for usage over 10,000 gallons**

**Residential Seasonal - \$100 + \$10.00 per 1,000 gallons for usage over 10,000 gallons**

## DIRECTIONS

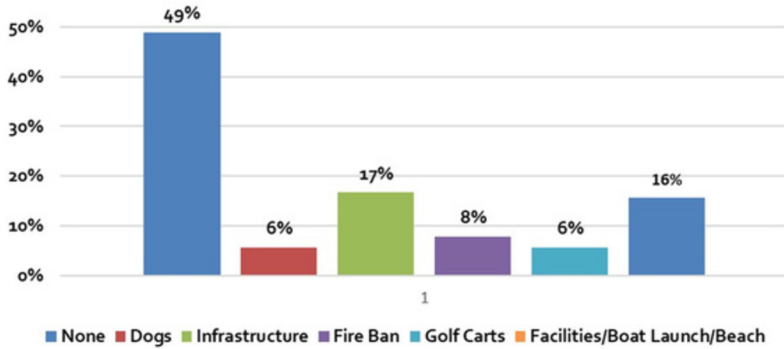
1. In a large bowl, mix together Corn Chex, Wheat Chex, Pretzels, Mini Marshmallows, and M&Ms.

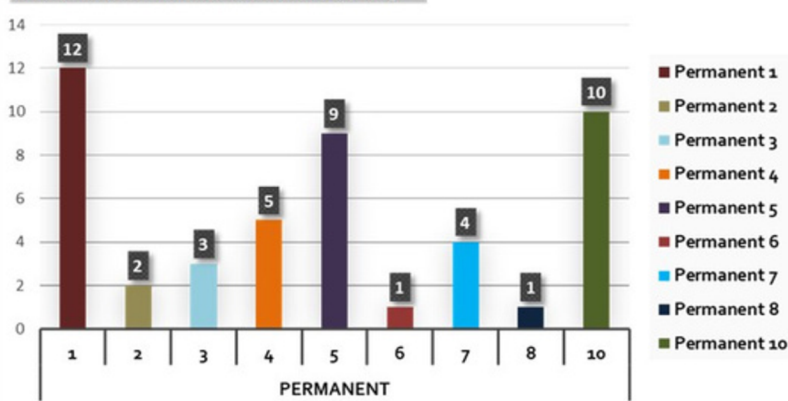
## Were there any issues that arose over summer?



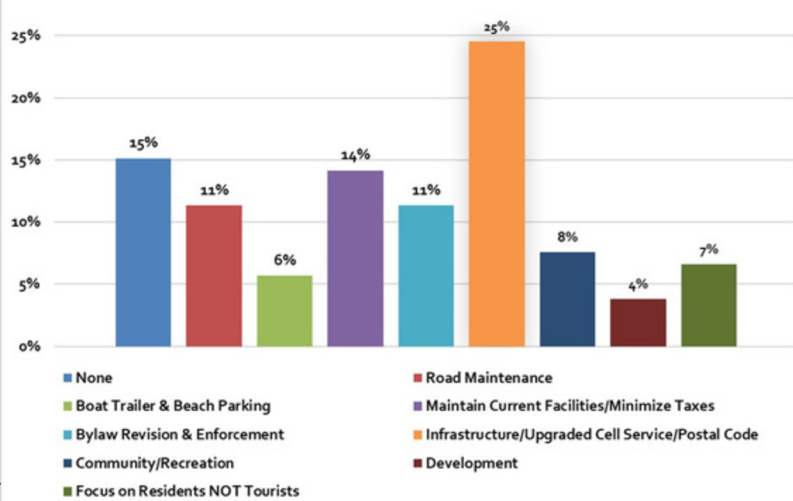

### How important is the need for additional boat trailer parking?

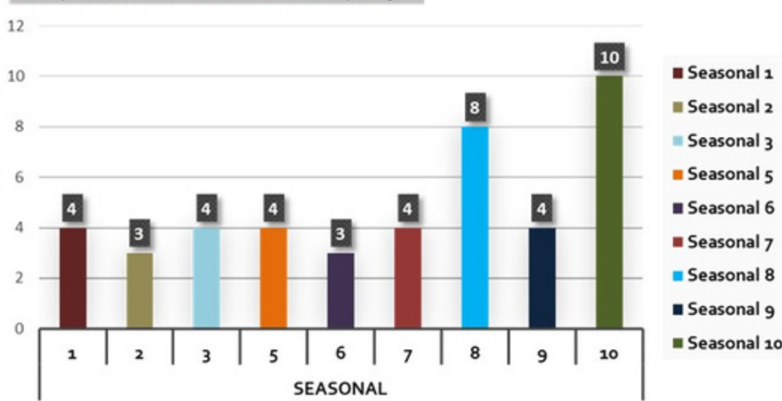

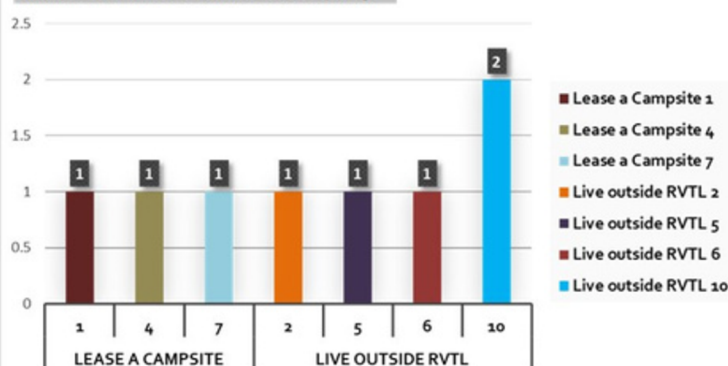
