

BYLAW NO 1/98

A Bylaw to regulate the operation of All Terrain Vehicles.

The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this section/bylaw:
 - a) "all terrain vehicles" means all terrain vehicles as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act;
 - b) "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act;
 - c) "public land" means public land as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act;
 - d) "vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.
2. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any public property within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake identified in Appendix 1.
3. A person is authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle on any street or highway, other than provincial highway No. 255, within the Resort Village of Tobin Lake for the purpose of leaving and returning home by the shortest and most direct route available.
4. All persons operating an all terrain vehicle in this bylaw are imposed with a twenty (20) kilometer per ~~hour~~ ^{hour} speed limit within the boundaries of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake.
5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
