TRAFFIC BYLAW Resort Village of Tobin Lake BYLAW NO 03/2021

A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATIONS OF TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES.

The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Definitions

- 1. In this bylaw;
- a. "Public Highway" means any street, lane, or public highway within the village, but does not include a provincial highway therein as designated pursuant to the provisions of The Highways Act;
- b. "Motor Vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Vehicles Act;
- c. "Unit" means a single recreational vehicle, trailer coach, mobile home, truck camper, motor home, fifth wheel, park model and travel trailer or other such approved accommodation intended for use in a trailer park, campground, RV park or mobile home park and intended to be used as living quarters;
- d. "RV" means recreation vehicle;
- e. "Shack" means a portable shed and an ice fishing shack.
- d. "Council" means the Council of The Resort Village of Tobin Lake;
- e. "Road Allowance" means means a road allowance laid out pursuant to the authority of an Act or an Act of the Parliament of Canada and established as part of the original quadrilateral township system of survey.
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle in the Resort Village of Tobin Lake at a speed greater than thirty (30) kms per hour.
- 3. The provisions of section 2 shall not apply to firefighting equipment or to motor vehicles being operated by law enforcement officers.
- 4. No person shall cause a motor vehicle to cross over or make a turn on any street except at intersections or driveways.
- 5. No person shall park a vehicle in any lane nor in any street as to impede or block the normal traffic flow to any lane or to a driveway or approach leading to private premises.
- 6. No person shall park or store a trailer, motor vehicle, RV, unit or shack in any public highway nor any road allowance for a period of longer than twenty four (24) hours and must be parallel parked in the direction of traffic flow.
- 7. No person shall park a motor vehicle within fifteen (15) feet of any street intersection.

- 8. The council may by resolution provide for the erection and maintenance on any highway, and at any designated point or points thereon, of such signs as it may deem expedient for warning, guidance, direction or infraction thereon.
- 9. No person shall, except where authorized by resolution of the council or when duly authorized by law, erect upon or immediately adjacent to any highway, any permanent sign, marker, signal or light or any advertising sign or device.
- 10. No person shall deface, damage, destroy or remove any sign or marker erected pursuant to this bylaw.
- 11. No person shall blow horns excessively, and no person shall cause his vehicle to unnecessarily accelerate to the extent of throwing gravel, squealing tires, or make any unnecessary noise in the operation of a motor vehicle, upon a parking lot, a street or other place within the Resort Village of Tobin Lake.
- 12. Any person guilty of a breach of the provisions of this bylaw shall upon conviction thereof be liable to the penalties as imposed by the general penalty bylaw of the Village.
- 13. Bylaw No. 04/1974 is hereby repealed.
