TO PROVIDE A UNIFORM SYSTEM FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS

BYLAW NO. 15/2020

The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. That a uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings as shown on the attached map and which shall become part of this bylaw shall be used in the Resort Village of Tobin Lake
- 2. That all existing numbers of houses and other buildings not now conforming with the provision of this bylaw shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.
- 3. A separate number shall be assigned for each fifty (50) feet of a property, (more or less), to which the Village mapping has deemed to be considered the frontage.
- 4. Each house and/or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated. In the case of a corner lot that the front entrance is not located on the street that the civic address reads, the building shall bear the number on both sides. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear a separate number.
- 5. Numerals indicating the official number for each house or building or each front entrance to such building shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
- 6. Numerals shall be a minimum of four (4) inches.
- 7. The municipal clerk shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
- 8. It is an offense to contravene any provisions of this Bylaw. Any conviction of an offense is subject to the penalties as provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
- 9. Bylaw No. 02/1998 is hereby repealed.
