

## RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE BYLAW NO. 2024.03

## A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE A SPECIAL TAX FOR RESIDENT FACILITY PASS FEES

The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. A Special Tax be levied against each parcel of land with an occupied residence, for the purpose of Resident Facility Pass Fees.
- 2. The Resident Facility Pass Tax is intended to repair the cement pad and to repair the dock.
- 3. The tax rate is applied per parcel of land with an occupied residence to be levied against all assessed owners of land that include an occupied residence and shall be set at \$60.00.
- 4. Any person who considers that an error or omission was made in the application or calculation of the special tax on his or her property may notify the municipality in writing by August 30th requesting the council to review the application or calculation of the tax rate regarding the property in question.
- 5. The Administrator will notify the persons, who have requested a review, of the time and date the council will meet to hear and review the requests.
- 6. The taxes that are levied will be added to the tax roll as a special assessment against the property, when they become due and payable, and are recoverable in the same manner as other taxes.
- 7. Bylaw No. 2023.06 is now hereby repealed.
