**A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE IN THE  
PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR A ROAD CLOSURE**

WHEREAS Section 13 of The Municipalities Act, allows a municipality to permanently close a street or lane with the prior written consent of the Minister of Highways and Transportation and after having given the public notice of the proposed closure;


AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Transportation has consented to and Council has given the required public notice of the proposed closure;


THEREFORE, the Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts;

1. To permanently close the following public road described as:



2. That the Administrator undertakes such other things necessary to effect the intent of this Bylaw.

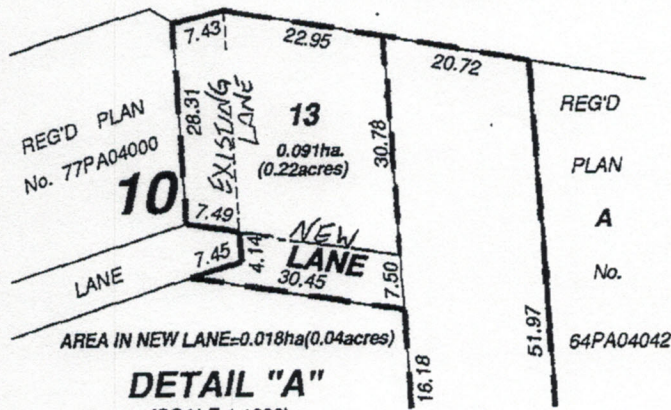
