## **BYLAW NO. 8/2013**

## A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A LIMIT ON CASH COLLECTIONS

The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:

a) "Designated officer" shall mean

i) the person appointed as the Administrator of the municipality; or

ii) the person who has been delegated authority to collect and deposit cash receipts belonging to the municipality;

b) "Council" means the Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake;

c) "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Tobin Lake.

2. The designated officer shall deposit in the name of the Municipality, in a financial institution designated by Council, all moneys collected and receipted when they have accumulated to the amount of \$ 10,000.00.

3. At the discretion of the designated officer, deposits may be made more frequently but in any case, not less than once a month nor more than once each day.
