1. Purpose

The purpose of this protocol is to give guidance on the use of masks and gloves required during the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. <u>Procedure</u>

2.1. The use of masks

When working on THE premises, it is mandatory to wear a facial cloth mask.

2.1.1. How to use a cloth mask

- Start of the new shift ensure that a new/cleaned mask is collected;
- Before touching the mask, clean your hands with either sanitiser or washing with soap and water;
- Inspect your mask for tears or holes;
- Fit the mask on your face and place the ear loops around your ears or tie at the back of your head;
- Adjust the mask over your face, covering your mouth, nose and chin;
- Do not remove the mask during the day except for lunch breaks.

2.1.2. How to remove a cloth mask

- Before touching the elastics/ties, clean your hands with either sanitiser or by washing with soap and water;
- Remove elastics/ties from behind ear/head and remove the mask by keeping it away from your face;
- During lunch breaks store the mask in a safe/clean area to avoid contamination and follow the 'How to use a mask' process before returning back to work;
- End of shift place the used mask in the designated laundry bins;
- All masks will be delivered to the laundrette and collected the day after depending on demand.

2.1.3. How to use an FFP2 mask (only to be used when the activity demands)

- Start of the new shift ensure that a new FFP2 mask is collected;
- Before touching the mask, clean your hands with either sanitiser or washing with soap and water;
- Inspect your mask for tears or holes;
- The top part of your mask is where the metal piece is situated which can bend;
- Fit the mask on your face and place the elasticated loops around your head;

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- Pinch the metal plate on top to ensure the mask is fitted correctly over your nose;
- Adjust the mask over your face, covering your mouth, nose and chin;
- Do not remove the mask during the day except for lunch breaks.

2.1.4. How to remove the FFP2 mask

- Before touching the elastics, clean your hands with either sanitiser or by washing with soap and water;
- Remove elastics from behind ear/head and remove the mask by keeping it away from your face;
- During lunch breaks store the mask in a safe/clean area to avoid contamination, and follow the 'How to FFP2' & FFP2' process before returning to work;
- End of the shifting place the used mask in the designated 'Biologica'hazard' bin for disposal.

2.2. The use of gloves

As per the WHO guidelines, the best way to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus is to clean your hands with a sanitiser or to wash your hands with soap and water.

Surgical gloves shouldn't be worn unless for attending to first aid incidents; first aiders should be trained in the proper use thereof.

Gloves must only be used when the activity demands the wearing of a specific type of hand gloves. Refer to your activity accurate risk assessment for more information.
