## 1. <u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this protocol is to give guidance to First aiders and other employees on acceptable practices when dealing with first aid cases, medical emergencies and managing close interaction.

# 2. <u>Procedure</u>

## 2.1. First Aid and Medical emergencies

The welfare of each employee is critical; adherence to this protocol is mandatory to minimise potential exposure to the Covid-19 virus.

All sections of the Emergency Procedure: PRO-IMS-010, and the Incident and Investigation Procedure: PRO-IMS-020, remain applicable, however, when dealing with an incident where first aid or medical treatment is needed during the period of the Covid-19 pandemic the following protocol applies.

## 2.1.1. Administering First Aid or Medical treatment

- Only competent appointed first aiders are authorised to administer first aid to an injured person;
- Ensure that the area is cleared from spectators to avoid contact;
- Before administering first aid ensure that your hands are washed with soap and warm water;
- Ensure that you use surgical gloves and that an FFPT2 facial mask and face shield is worn;
- If and when required contact medical services based on the extent of the incident. Refer to emergency contact numbers (FOR-IMS-010-01) displayed onsite notice boards and available under SHEQ file 1.

## 2.1.2. Post First Aid or Medical treatment

- Remove the surgical gloves:
  - Pinch and hold the **outside** of the glove near the wrist area;
  - Peel downwards, away from the wrist, turning the glove inside out;
  - Pull the glove away until it is removed from the hand and **hold the inside-out** glove with the gloved hand;
  - With your un-gloved hand, slide your finger/s **under the wrist** of the remaining glove, **taking care not to touch the outside of the glove**;
  - Again, peel downwards, away from the wrist, turning the glove inside out; and
  - Continue to pull the glove down and over the inside-out glove being held in your gloved hand.

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- This will ensure that both gloves are inside out, one glove enveloped inside the other, with no contaminant on the bare hands.
- After administering first aid, ensure your hands are washed with soap and water.
- Where reasonably practicable ensure that the injured person/treated person sanitise or wash their hands with soap and water.
- Ensure that the area where first aid and medical treatment was administered is disinfected.
- Ensure that all medical waste such as bandages, surgical gloves, plasters, gauze etc. are disposed of in the designated 'Biological Hazard' waste bin.
- Ensure that the incident is recorded and used contents of the first aid box are replaced.
