# Johnston Recreation Department's Summer Day Camp 2026: Field Trip Packet

## Drop-off and Pick-up Location:

- Field trip drop-off and pick-up will take place at the Johnston Memorial Park (JMP) – 1583 Hartford Ave, Johnston, RI 02919.
  - In the case of inclement weather, you will be notified via email if the drop-off/pick-up will be at the Ferri Middle School Gymnasium (10 Memorial Ave, Johnston, RI 02919).
- You are **NOT** allowed to drop your child off at the field trip location and you are **NOT** allowed to pick your child up at the field trip location (*unless in the case of an emergency and have the approval of the Camp Director and Recreation Director*).
  - In the case of a situation in which we feel like we need parent assistance regarding unsafe behavior, we will make a phone call for your child to be picked up from the field trip.
- Children must be signed in/out at JMP/FMS and children are only allowed to be picked up by those parties listed on their *Camper Registration Form*.
  - Please pre-screen your child(ren) for any signs of illness before coming to camp/field trips. Any child who is sick and/or experiencing symptoms should **NOT** come to camp or any field trips.

## Dates and Times:

- **Arrive at JMP:** please arrive at the Johnston Memorial Park (JMP) on time to ensure you don't miss the bus.
- **Return to JMP:** please note that the return times may vary depending on traffic.
  - You will be emailed if the bus is stuck in traffic and is anticipated to return later than the times listed.
- **Non-Campers:** If you are only signed up for a field trip and not the Summer Camp program, please arrive at the time listed for field trip departure and arrive to pick your child up at the time we are expected to return to camp (*i.e. the cost of the field trip is for the trip only, it does not include any time at the camp before or after the trip*).

## Field Trip Registration Information:

- Permission Slips, Forms, and Payments:
  - A parent/guardian **must** submit a completed *Camper Registration Form* for each in order to attend camp/field trips.
  - All campers/field trip participants and their parent/guardian **must** submit a signed *Campers' Code of Conduct* in order to attend camp/field trips.
  - **All field trip permission slips MUST be completed/signed and are due a week in advance with payment.**
    - We have to submit our headcount to facilities and pay for transportation in advance.
    - We will **NOT** accept trip registrations on the day of the trip.
- Maximum Registration Numbers Per Trip:
  - All trips have a maximum number of children who can attend the trip.
  - While field trips are open to campers enrolled in our Summer Day Camp as well as non-campers, first preference will go to those children enrolled in our Summer Day Camp.
- Low Registration Numbers Per Trip:
  - All field trips have a minimum number of attendees needed.
  - If a trip is cancelled due to low registration numbers/changes from the facility, you will receive a full refund or a credit to be used towards the payment of other field trips.

## Pricing:

- Field trips are an additional cost per camper (no sibling discount).
- Trip pricing includes the cost of the trip itself as well as the cost of transportation.
- A spot for a field trip is only held once the trip is paid for in full and the form/waiver(s) for the trip are turned in.

- Once you have registered your child(ren) for a field trip, you will **not** be eligible for a refund without a doctor's note.
  - You will **not** receive a refund if you are late and miss the bus/do not have the trip requirements/ are not wearing the Day Camp shirt.
  - You will **not** receive a refund if your camper is not allowed to go on the field trip due to violating the camp safety rules/violating the *Campers' Code of Conduct*.
- Field Trip Payments:
  - Trips can be paid for with cash, check, or money order (checks/money orders made out to Johnston Youth Sports Association).

## What to Wear, Special Trip Requirements, and Lunch:

- **Shirts:** Camper **MUST** wear their Johnston Recreation Summer Day Camp t-shirts on ALL trips.
  - If your child does not have their Day Camp shirt, they will **NOT** be able to attend the trip and you will **NOT** be eligible for a refund.
- **Special Trip Requirements:** Certain field trips have requirements such as specific footwear, socks, waivers, etc.
  - If your child does not have the necessary items, they will **NOT** be allowed to participate on the trip and you will **NOT** be eligible for a refund.
  - This information will be listed under *What to Bring & Other Important Trip Information*.
- **Lunch:** We will be eating lunch at the field trip location for the majority of the field trips.
  - The free lunches from Citizens Bank will **NOT** be available on trips *unless* otherwise noted.
  - Some field trips have special information for lunch such as being a **nut-free facility** and having places to order lunch. This information will be listed under *What to Bring & Other Important Trip Information*.

## Miscellaneous Information:

- Please inform the Recreation Department of all important medical information.
- Be sure your child knows what field trips they are signed up for to avoid any confusion.
- Please write your child's name on all personal belongings taken to camp/field trips.
  - *Lost and Found Items:* The lost and found bin will be sorted through and items will be donated or thrown away at the end of each camp week.
- **Money:** Certain field trips have optional fees (such as arcade games, concession, gift shops, etc. – all listed in the *What to Bring & Other Important Trip Information*). If you plan on sending your camper with extra money for these amenities, your camper can carry it themselves or you can give it to the camp administration at the front table who will put it in a sandwich baggie labeled with their name and directly hand it to your child's group leader to hang on to it for them.
- **Phones, Valuables, Electronics, and Cellphones:**
  - Please **DO NOT** send your child to camp with electronics **OR** any valuable possessions: electronic devices such as cellphones, iPods, iPads, tablets, and video games are **NOT** permitted at camp. Pokémon cards/trading cards/sports cards are **NOT** permitted at camp.
  - The Johnston Recreation Department is **NOT** responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property.
  - Campers' Cellphone Policy:
    - We understand that some campers may need to bring a phone with them in case of an emergency, however cellphone use will be extremely limited to just that.
    - Campers will be asked to put their phone in their backpack if they are seen watching videos/surfing the web/visiting social media sites, playing videos/games/music, etc.
    - If a cellphone is being abused, it will be confiscated and given back to the parent at the end of the day.
- **Behavioral Expectations:**
  - Campers are expected to follow all of the rules set forth by the field trip facility.
  - All campers/field trip participants are expected to follow all expectations and guidelines set forth in the *Johnston Recreation Department's Campers' Code of Conduct* (which can be seen on pages 13-14 of the *Johnston Recreation Department's Summer Day Camp: 2026 Parent Packet*).
  - Regardless of the age of the camper, the expectation of language/topics/gestures used is expected to be school-appropriate behavior.

**WAIVER, RELEASE, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT****PLEASE READ THIS DOCUMENT CAREFULLY. BY SIGNING, YOU ARE GIVING UP LEGAL RIGHTS**

This Waiver, Release, and Indemnification Agreement (Agreement) is entered into by Adult Participant on behalf of itself and the Other Participants, whether as their parent, legal guardian, representative, or otherwise in favor of Ripston and Medeiros Inc (Urban Air). Other Participant shall mean the children or other persons identified below. Collectively and severally, Adult Participant and Other Participant, their representatives, executors, estate, heirs, successors, and assigns are referred to as Participant. In consideration of Urban Air permitting Participant to enter the Premises and participate in the Activities, including the Activities that may occur in, about, or near 300 Quaker Lane, Warwick, RI 02886 or any other premises owned or operated by Urban Air wherever located (Premises), Participant agrees as follows on behalf of itself and all Participants identified below:

1. **NATURE OF THE ACTIVITIES.** Urban Air operates a trampoline and adventure park, which offers Participants (a) the opportunity to participate actively or passively, in trampoline and adventure park related activities, including, but not limited to, jumping, dodgeball, volleyball, tumbling, foam pit jumping, aerobics, skydiving, ninja warrior course, battle beam, laser tag, soft play, ropes course, climbing wall, twist tower, roller coaster, sky rider, go carts, bowling, bumper cars, cyber sports, mini golf, arcades, exercising, and other miscellaneous trampoline and adventure activities, instruction, training, fitness classes, competition, events, and programs and (b) access to the Premises and cafe (collectively, Activities). It is important that the Participants know that trampoline and adventure activities are active and vigorous and consequently, involve some risks of injury or death that are inherent to the activity

2. **TYPES OF RISKS.**

2.1 **RISKS AND INJURIES ASSOCIATED WITH ACTIVITIES.** Participant acknowledges there are inherent risks in and injuries that may occur from participating in the Activities, including, but not limited to, equipment malfunction; defective design or manufacture of equipment; improper or negligent installation of equipment; negligent maintenance of equipment; cuts; bruises; muscle strain; twisted or sprained ankles, knees, shoulders, or wrists; burns; dirt or other materials in eye; concussions; dizziness; broken bones; physical or emotional injuries; landing wrong; over-exertion; failure of the attraction surface or attachments; being hit by a ball; collisions with other participants; erratic co-participant behavior; collisions with standards and supports; using improper form or technique; slipping, falling, or tripping; equipment failure; error of judgment by employees; paralysis, disability, or death; personal injury to third persons; or property damage. When skydiving, the most common risk of injury is to the shoulders due to the force of the air on them. When participating in cyber or e-sports, the most common risk of injury is a seizure due to epilepsy. Due to the nature of the Activities, there are more hazards and risks than the foregoing, and there are also unknown and unforeseeable hazards. If you have any questions, please contact a manager before purchasing admission.

2.2 **EXPOSURE TO BACTERIA, FUNGI, VIRUSES AND UNKNOWN CONTAGIOUS DISEASES.** By entering the Premises or when engaging in the Activities, there is a risk of exposure to bacteria, fungi, viruses, unknown contagious diseases, and COVID-19, which notwithstanding governmental recommendations and the practices of Urban Air, cannot be eliminated. **CONSEQUENTLY, TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, PARTICIPANT KNOWINGLY AND FULLY ASSUMES THE RISK OF, RELEASES, AND SHALL INDEMNIFY URBAN AIR FROM ALL CLAIMS (AS DEFINED IN SECTION 5 BELOW) OR BODILY INJURY RESULTING FROM PARTICIPANT'S EXPOSURE TO ANY BACTERIA, FUNGUS, VIRUS, UNKNOWN CONTAGIOUS DISEASES OR COVID-19 AND IN ANY WAY CONNECTED TO PARTICIPANT'S ENTRY INTO THE PREMISES OR ENGAGEMENT IN THE ACTIVITIES. FURTHER, ADULT PARTICIPANT ON BEHALF OF HIM/HERSELF AND THAT OF THE OTHER PARTICIPANT(S) CONSENTS TO HAVING THEIR TEMPERATURE TAKEN BY URBAN AIR AND ACKNOWLEDGES THEY MAY BE DENIED ACCESS TO OR FORCED TO VACATE THE PREMISES IF THEY EVIDENCE SYMPTOMS OF EXPOSURE TO BACTERIA, FUNGUS, VIRUSES, UNKNOWN CONTAGIOUS DISEASES OR COVID-19 AS IDENTIFIED BY THE CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION.**

3. **ASSUMPTION OF RISKS.** Notwithstanding the foregoing risks and the safety measures implemented by Urban Air, Participant acknowledges it is impossible to eliminate all risk of injury and understands the demands of the Activities relative to Participant's physical condition and skill level. **PARTICIPANT AFFIRMS THAT PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES IS VOLUNTARY AND PARTICIPANT KNOWINGLY, WITH UNDERSTANDING OF THE RISKS AND POTENTIAL INJURIES, ASSUMES ALL RISKS INHERENT WITH THE ACTIVITIES AND ACCESS TO THE PREMISES.**

4. **ALCOHOL.** Participant agrees to exercise ordinary and reasonable care and to not consume alcohol to the extent Participant's judgment is impaired. Participant understands the potential risks associated with the consumption of alcohol and acknowledges Participant does not have and is not aware of any medical condition that would result in any injury to Participant due to Participant's consumption of alcohol. Participant assumes the risks associated with alcohol consumption and takes full responsibility for Participant's own actions, safety, and welfare. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL PARTICIPANT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITIES IF PARTICIPANT HAS CONSUMED ALCOHOL.**
