FLAMES GO 3-1 IN FALL STATE CLASSIC

The Flames made an impressive run to claim 4th place in the 12AA Fall State Classic held in Peoria on November 2-3, 2024. They kicked off the tournament on Saturday with a thrilling showdown against the Devilbacks 12U Black. In a high-scoring, back-and-forth battle, the Flames ultimately prevailed, edging out a 15-14 victory in four intense innings.

Their second game of the day against the Arizona Hitmen Baseball Club started with a challenge, as the Hitmen racked up 10 runs in the first inning. Unfazed, the Flames roared back, scoring 12 to close the inning ahead. The Flames' defense tightened up in the second, holding the Hitmen to a single run, while their bats stayed hot. They piled on nine more runs before the game was cut short due to the time limit, clinching a decisive 20-11 win.

With two victories in pool play, the Flames entered the gold bracket in 4th place. Their first bracket matchup was a nail-biting game against the NAZ Outlaws 12U, ending with a 7-6 walk-off victory for the Flames.

In their final game of the weekend, the Flames faced off against the top-seeded S.A.B.A. Green. Ben's home run provided a spark, but despite their best efforts, the Flames fell 9-1. Nonetheless, it was a strong showing for the Flames in their first tournament, marking an exciting start to their season.

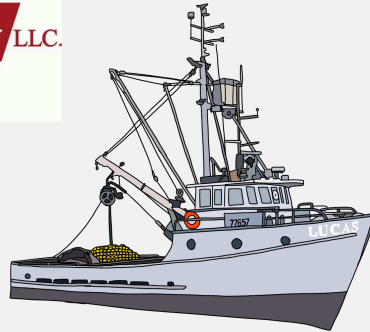
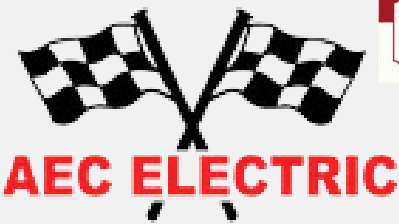
