

- Make your Reconciliation


With urgency, Pope Leo XIII developed the St. Michael's Prayer to be said at the end of low Masses to overcome the devil's plan by asking us to say:

ALL SAINTS DAY

We are all called to be saints. Through our Baptism and Confirmation we have become children of God through His Son Jesus.

Why do we take a Saints name? Emeritus Benedict XVI said during a Baptism at the Vatican, “The point, to be consecrated to God in a special way.”

The Baptism name is the character of the Son of God. We are known as by that given name. It reflects our faith and traditions. We are changed into a new creation in Christ.

Moses translates to, he was drawn out of the water. John the Baptist translates to, remembered as God’s gift.

In Poland, parents named their baby after the saints feast date closest to the day they were born. My Mom was born on St. Bartholomew saints day. So she was named after St. Rose of Lima, the saints day, on the day before for her protection and guidance for my Mom. My father was the last of 8 children, so was named after St. Louis to protect and to guide him. In Poland he celebrated his saints day as his birthday, not the day he was born.

In Our Lady of Grace Gift Shop, I bought a book and a pillow case with my saint’s picture on it and her prayer or story. It is amazing how when reading about my saint, the story sounds so familiar.

What saint is your church named for? That saint protects and guides your church.

We will be honored to witness two Popes who will become saints before the end of 2013.

Blessed John Paul II and Blessed John XXIII. We will hear their story and how they are declared saints and the persons who were healed through the Pope’s intercession. Keep them all in our prayers.

Blessed Jacinta and Blessed Francisco, visionaries in Fatima, are awaiting confirmation of miracles of healing through their intercession together. May we continue to keep them and Lucia in our prayers for their Sainthood.

ALL SOULS DAY

“I HAVE COMPETED WELL; I HAVE FINISHED THE RACE; I HAVE KEPT THE FAITH. FROM NOW ON THE CROWN OF RIGHTEOUSNESS AWAITS ME, WHICH THE LORD, THE JUST JUDGE, WILL AWARD TO ME ON THAT DAY, AND NOT ONLY TO ME, BUT TO ALL WHO HAVE LONGED FOR HIS APPEARANCE.” (2 Timothy 4:6-8)

When I sing in the Resurrection choir, I hear this reading many times. The eulogies are very moving, reflecting the person’s life and how they ran the race, kept the faith, through many trials of life. It makes me feel honored to sing for them. It humbles me that God has given me an opportunity to witness their testimony.

How well are we running the race of life within our daily duties?

My father once said that his inheritance is, that a part of him will always live on through his children and his grandchildren. In Deuteronomy 4:9-10 describes “spiritual inheritance.” It says , “However, take care and be earnestly on your guard not to forget the things which your own eyes have seen, nor let them slip from your memory as long as you shall live; but teach them to your children and your children’s children: There was the day on which you stood before the Lord, your God at Horeb, and he said to me, ‘Assemble the people for me; I will have them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me as long as they live in the land and may so teach their children.’



When God calls us home, what will he ask of us? My Dad used to say, Joanne, “when you get to St. Peter’s gate, no complaining. God is not going to ask what other’s did but what you did; where you made a difference. We all make mistakes. We’re human, but it is what you do about it, that counts.” As Lucia would ask Blessed Mother, “What do you want of me?”

We teach our children a great deal by our actions and how we react to situations and overcoming them in our lives. May we follow the actions of Jesus and Mary to follow our Lord the rest of our lives. Do we pray, go to church, give to the poor? I found special prayer cards in my parents prayer books after they passed onto the next life. I am my parents daughter. My inheritance is my faith. Thank you, Mom and Dad, for teaching the joy and comfort, and especially God’s love in our faith. Amen.

There is the “right way,” the “wrong “way. AND THEN THERE IS GOD’S WAY. Let’s choose God’s way. We can’t go wrong. Jesus, I trust in You.

*On June 13, 1917, Our Lady of Fatima appeared to 3 shepherd children saying, "Many souls go to Hell because they have no one to pray and offer sacrifices for them." She also said to Lucia, the oldest seer, "God wishes you to remain in the world for some time because He wants to use you to establish in the world the devotion to my Immaculate Heart. I promise salvation to those who embrace it, and their souls will be loved by God as flowers placed by myself to adorn His throne."

On Dec. 10, 1925, Blessed Mother and Christ Child appeared. The Christ Child said, "Have pity on the heart of your Most Holy Mother. It is covered with thorns with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment, and there is no one to remove them with an act of reparation." as Blessed Mother held a heart encircled with sharp thorns repeated about what ungrateful men placement of the thorns and added, "You at least try to console me. Announce in my name that I promise to assist at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for salvation , all those who, on the 1st five Saturdays of five consecutive months , go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, recite the Rosary, and keep me company for a quarter of an hour while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with intention of making reparation to me."

1.) Penance and make reparations, PRAYER: "*o my Jesus, I offer this for love of Thee, for the conversion of poor sinners, and in reparation for all the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.*" Pope Francis called the Bishop of Fatima and asked him to go to the apparition site and ask Our Lady bless his pontificate twice.

2.) Recitation daily of the Rosary, She added the Decade Prayer, "*Oh my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of Thy mercy.*" Pope Francis led the Rosary on the day of Prayer and Fasting on Saturday, on 1st Saturday, Sept. 7th, for peace in Syria, the Middle East and The World.

3.) Five First Saturdays. (See the June 13, 1917 information on left.) Pope Francis lives and leads by example in his Pontificate; he does 1st Saturday devotion every month.

4.) Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, our Hope. Pope Pius XII warned a few months after World War II, " Men must prepare themselves for suffering such as mankind has never seen." Photo page 1 of the 3rd Secret and join us saying the Consecration Prayer on Oct. 13th, 2013.(**Because consecration not done during Pope Pius XI as Our Lady asked. Now spread throughout the world, spread passed Russia.**)
