committed to our crib project.

Krier's Candy bill from our annual meeting.

new fish cribs were sunk, and their plans might  
give our project a different option, he will

Protection Area Ordinance.  
Wednesday April 11th, 2018 @ 8:30am  
in Sawyer County Courthouse.  
If passed as proposed, this ordinance  
would impact Moose Lake in pretty  
significant ways.
