Fireworks Reminder – Some fireworks in Wisconsin are illegal while some are permitted. The difference is this. Fireworks that explode or leave the ground without a valid permit issued by the town is illegal in the state of Wisconsin and in the Town of Round Lake. This includes firecrackers, bottle rockets, roman candles, and mortars. Selling these to Wisconsin residents without a permit is also illegal. (Wis. Stat. §167.10; Sawyer County Ordinance 1.04). July 4th Fireworks / Fireworks will start Friday at 10:00 pm. In the past, a "safety zone" was designated on the lawn in front of Louie's Landing. This year, the "safety zone" will be extended from shore into the water. A perimeter will be set up in the water, marked by buoys. Please stay outside of the area marked by these buoys for your own safety, as some fireworks will be exploding in the water. Stay safe and enjoy the fireworks from your watercraft!!
