Moose Lake Improvement Association Board Minutes December 5th, 2024

Meeting was called to order by President McDonald at 9:04 @ Christina's Y-Pines

Board members Absent: Dane Resh

Guests: Mike Feldner, Jim StrandLund, Vaughn Christison, Dave Sanders, Jim Weidling.

Adoption of Agenda as mailed: Hostetler moved to accept as published, seconded by Brown, passed.

Approval of the Minutes as posted: Kuchta moved to accept Minutes as posted on our website, Hostetler seconded, passed.

Treasurers report: Kuchta commented on a few larger entries from mailing the directory leaving us a balance of \$ 13,654.60

Membership: Kuchta said he had nothing new, but requested help trimming back the mailing list, and adhering to the policy that only paying members and advertiser get a copy.

Old Business

Wally Erickson Memorial - Koehler reported that he has physical possession of the memorial and will install same this spring when lake returns to full pool.

Membership List - Kuchta requested help from McDonald and Broberg to help identifying names that should be removed.

Moose Lake Club boat landing - Koehler reported that the Town of Round Lake has accepted our offer of building and installing a new public dock, one that we will maintain on a year to year basis, a structure that will not accommodate over night parking of water craft.

He also pointed out that TRL has already removed the old dock, and that a building plan will be forthcoming.

Folsom Island Dock/Picnic Area updating - Koehler will present a plan for dock renovation in March. He promoted replacing the existing dock with one that will accommodate two pontoons, with a 6' walkway. Eisenbacher volunteered his heated shed for building and a direct access to the lake.

Buoy Update - McDonald reported that the previous sponsor of the defunct buoy has elected to continue their sponsorship, thus there will be no lottery.

New Business

McDonald reported that Dane Resh has submitted his resignation from the board. We will miss Dane's participation and Thank him for his past service.

A motion from the floor to consider Vaughn Christison as a replacement, at the meeting the position outline and expectations were explained to Vaughn, after which he expressed interest. A motion by Kuchta and seconded by Hostetler to offer Christison the position, passed, he accepted.

A request found it's way to the board about working on building a fifth boat landing on Moose Lake, a lively discussion incurred with the general consensus that there are already three free launch sites and one for profit, which it is felt adequate.

Committee Reports

Town of Round Lake - Jim Strandlund reported

- * TRL has already removed the defunct boat dock at Moose Lake Club landing, and Ok'd our plan to build a new one.
- * TRL has been approached on other lakes about putting a port-a-potty at some boat landings.
- * TRL is further discussing new ordinances for the short-term rental establishments.

Round Lake Fire Department - Mike Feldner

- * he addressed the power outage area electric customers endured, it seems an individual lost control of their care and crashed into one of Jump Rivers sub-stations Luckily the individual wasn't harmed.
- * Mike thanked all the people that contacted the county about a Moose Lake ambulance garage, hopefully we will see some movement on this topic.
- * If you are in need of Help please call 9-11 directly.
- * Mike wanted us to know of an instance where the TRL and the fire Auxiliary worked togather to create a slush fund which allowed the fire department to

bid on a slightly used truck the state was selling at auction. It is good to know government agency's can work with private groups when needed.
