What we're learning

Math

Reviewing fractions. Comparing fractions with same/different denominators.

Reading

Reading nonfiction text- Understanding the text structures and using text features to build on comprehension. Reading about holiday traditions around the world.

Writing & grammar

Verb Types, parts of speech, Possessive Nouns
Paragraph writing: working on Capitalization, Punctuation, Transition words, Topic Sentence, and Closing Sentence (Narrative Writing, Informative writing)

Reminders
