What is the End-Of-Year Project?

Scholars were instructed to come up with a detailed project that they can relate to the lessons we had in Life Skills this year. Some students are coming up with community gardens, some are building new cities, some are creating budgeting handbooks; the options are limitless!

Scholars must create a slideshow about their project, write about how it connects to life skills, and have a physical example of their project. Many students are building models out of cardboard, popsicle sticks, glue, etc. Their creativity and determination is inspiring!

What are the Engineering and Technology Eras?

Scholars are learning about key inventions from 4 different eras (Stone Age, Industrial Age, Modern Age, Digital Age). We analyze the ways that these inventions were made, how they have evolved over time, and the societal and environmental impacts these inventions have.
