Academics and State Standards...

Reading/Language Arts:

Match oral words to written words, identify letters, words, and sentences, distinguish beginning, middle, and ending sounds, create and state a series of rhyming words, read common sight words, identify title, author, illustrator, identify parts of a story and be able to retell what happened, describe the roles of authors and illustrators, print legibly.

Math/Calendar:

Count, read, write #s to 50, show the meaning of addition and subtraction using objects and touchpoints, arrange whole numbers in order to 10 forwards and backwards, read and write number words to 10, describe shapes: circles, triangles, squares and rectangles and find them in the environment, comparing numbers to ten and 5 and 10 relationships and counting by 5s and 10s to 100.

Social Studies/Science:

Social Studies: identify American songs and symbols, understand the meaning of the pledge, sequence events with time, understand and show good citizenship, Science: observe, describe and draw objects to learn about them, magnifiers help people see things better, water can be a liquid or a solid, investigate and make observations to seek answers.
