

I have visited Moldova eight times and seen with my own eyes the beauty, the culture, and the poverty of Moldova. This poverty results in preventable suffering from chronic diseases. Many Moldovans go about their lives not knowing they have diabetes or heart disease. With my unique skills as a health librarian, in 1999 I established the first consumer health library in NC, here in Wilmington. I know how much this health library helped residents become aware of their health status, and subsequently try to improve their health. I know this same technique can work in Moldova.



A second reason, and really the main reason I am doing this, goes all the way back to me being a teenager growing up in NC in the late1960s. My best friend's father fled his eastern European home in 1944 when Communism took over his country and many other countries too. I felt his pain and always wanted to help him and others who had suffered like this, no matter how far away. When I became a librarian who worked with international librarianship, I wanted to use my own library skills and my passion for the people of eastern Europe and do something good for the libraries and the citizens in this section of the world. I wanted to bring my librarian skills and friendship to them.

Goals of the Grant

To combat diabetes, heart disease, stroke and COVID in Moldova by:

- Establishing health education rooms inside Moldovan college and university libraries.
- Moldovan citizens can visit these libraries to learn healthy life style choices and disease avoidance.

The grant will provide each library with:

- Books in Romanian and Russian languages
- A computer, printer, and scanner
- Furniture
- A blood pressure monitor

A health educator will provide health talks in each library twice a month.

Background:

North Carolina and the Eastern European country of Moldova entered into a Bi-lateral partnership in 1999, when North Carolina Governor Hunt appointed North Carolina Secretary of State, Elaine Marshall, to coordinate the project and encourage partnerships.



The partnership has grown quickly and today there are partnerships between Moldova and North Carolina in multiple areas.
