Stop and Wait to be asked to enter pool building.



After entering the pool area, proceed to one of the 3 designated seating areas (marked with red tape).



Place all personal items in the container/fexitub provided.



All spectators are to remain in their chosen designated waiting area for the duration of the lesson.



Before leaving please wipe chairs with disinfectant wipe, place used wipe in the rubbish bin outside the door, then



Please spray chairs with antiviral spray and leave to air dry.



Exit pool building immediately at the end of your lesson - clothing changes are permitted if needed but are to be done with haste.

1. Limiting patrons in the facility to the maximum of 12.
2. Have implemented measures to ensure social distancing requirements are met in the facility with the introduction of a temporary class schedule and have allowed time for change over between lessons.
3. Increased cleaning of high touch areas, increased cleaning and minimised use of shared equipment
4. Amendments have been made to level programs to minimise contact to between participants where possible and practical.

➤ **ARRIVING AND LEAVING**

Please do not enter pool gate any earlier than 5 minutes prior to the start of your lesson time. Enter the pool building only when directed to do so (1st lesson of the session may enter upon arrival).

“Beach Ready - Wrap and Go” – is preferred where possible

Please have swimmers arrive in swimwear ready to swim and where possible leave directly at the end of their lesson. If we are experiencing a cool day, make sure your swimmer is covered up warmly (ie swim jacket/coat, dressing gown, ugg boots/slippers, beanie, or hair towel wrap. Changes after swimming will now be allowed but must be done with haste to

Where possible at the end of your lesson please leave the pool area immediately after rinsing off. Changing from wet swimwear to dry/warm clothes is now permitted, when possible and practical please move outside the pool building to marked designated outside change areas. All changes must be done with as much haste as possible, to ease congestion within the pool building and pool yard. Changing of clothes/swimwear at home before and after lessons is still highly recommended.

➤ **PERSONAL ITEMS**

Please keep personal items to a minimum and place **ALL** belongings in the flexitub/container provided in each seating area and at change mats.

➤ **SEATING**

Limited seating will be available in the viewing area and there is to be no spectator access to the northern end of pool deck, no entry past the penguin and 1st bamboo plant.

Please sit on chairs provided in marked designated seating areas only.



Families are now requested to assist by wiping down any chairs, flexitubs/containers, change mats and any other hard surfaces that may have been touched during their visit, with provided antibacterial wipes first and then spray with antiviral disinfectant – allow to air dry.

If seating requires drying upon your arrival please use yellow clothes provided to dry and place used cloth in the rubbish bin outside the door.

All wipes, sprays and cloths are provided for each seating area.

Used wipes are to be disposed of on the way out in the blue bin situated outside the front door.

Zeeswim Aquademy will wipe down and spray between each lesson (toilet area, shower and front door), in addition to our hourly clean (wipe down and spray all chairs in seating areas).
