[REDACTED] THIS INVESTIGATION ALSO INCLUDED INTERVIEWS WITH FAMILY DAY CARE CHILDREN AND/OR THEIR FAMILIES. THOSE STATEMENTS INDICATE NO EVIDENCE OF ABUSIVE ACTIONS AGAINST ANY DAY CARE CHILDREN.

REGARDING ALLEGATION #2, THE EVIDENCE, INCLUDING A POLICE INVESTIGATION, INDICATE THERE IS INSUFFICIENT EVIDENCE TO SUBSTANTIATE JAMES DUNN SEXUALLY MOLESTED SEVEN YEAR OLD CINDY [REDACTED]. THE EVIDENCE INCLUDES MATTER-OF-FACT AND CONSISTENT STATEMENTS BY CINDY [REDACTED] TO SEVERAL ADULTS INCLUDING THIS INVESTIGATOR [ATTACHMENT 14, 15, 16, 17]. HOWEVER, EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES, INCLUDING SIMILAR ALLEGATIONS OF ABUSE ARISING FROM ANOTHER FOSTER CHILD IN THE WILKERSON FOSTER HOME, MAY HAVE INFLUENCED CINDY [ATTACHMENT 16]. THE RECORD SHOWS THE WILKERSON HOME IS THE FOSTER PLACEMENT WHERE CINDY MOVED TO AFTER LEAVING THE DUNN'S HOME. DUE TO THE SIMILARITIES OF THE ALLEGATIONS ARISING FROM THE WILKERSON FOSTER HOME AND THE FACT THERE IS NO OTHER COLLABORATING EVIDENCE OF CINDY'S CLAIM, THIS ALLEGATION IS FOUND INCONCLUSIVE.
