



HISTORY OF SPIRITUAL WELLNESS MONTH

It may involve believing in a supernatural realm beyond the ordinarily observable world, personal growth, a quest for an ultimate or sacred meaning, religious experience, or an encounter with one's own 'inner dimension.'

Spiritual wellness has a lot of benefits for everyone who follows through to intentionally practice it. When you strengthen your spiritual wellness you fortify your relationships with people and bring positivity into spaces. "Money"

Sunday, March 02, 2025

Genesis 42:23-25

Minister: And they knew not that Joseph understood *them;* for he spake unto them by an interpreter.

Congregation: And he turned himself about from them, and wept; and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them Simeon, and bound him before their eyes.

All: Then Joseph commanded to fill their sacks with corn, and to restore every man's money into his sack, and to give them provision for the way: and thus did he unto them.

Sunday, March 09, 2025

Ecclesiastes 10:14-19

Minister: A fool also is full of words: a man cannot tell what shall be; and what shall be after him, who can tell him?

Congregation: The labour of the foolish wearieth every one of them, because he knoweth not how to go to the city.

Minister: Woe to thee, O land, when thy king *is* a child, and thy princes eat in the morning!

Congregation: Blessed *art* thou, O land, when thy king *is* the son of nobles, and thy princes eat in due season, for strength, and not for drunkenness!

Minister: By much slothfulness the building decayeth; and through idleness of the hands the house droppeth through.

All: A feast is made for laughter, and wine maketh merry: but money answereth all *things*.

St. Matthew 6:20-24

Minister: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

Congregation: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Minister: The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, they whole body shall be full of light.

Congregation: But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light, that is in thee be darkness, how great *is* that darkness!

All: No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mam'-mon.

Sunday, March 23, 2025

Acts 8:16-20

Minister: (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.)

Congregation: Then laid they *their* hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.

Minister: And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money,

Congregation: Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

All: But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money.

Sunday, March 30, 2025

I Timothy 6:6-10

Minister: But godliness with contentment is great gain.

Congregation: For we brought nothing into *this* world, *and it is* certain we can carry nothing out.

Minister: And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.

Congregation: But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and *into* many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.

All: For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
