RECOMMENDED PRODUCTS

Granular Fertiliser	 Look for a high quality fertiliser containing nitrogen ('N' in the range of 15-20), Potassium ('K') and maybe some iron ('Fe') as well. This provides your lawn with these vital nutrients in a slow release form. Avoid straight urea products as these push growth quickly but can quite easily damage your lawn.
Liquid Fertiliser	 For Colour: Look for liquid fertiliser products that contain iron and some nitrogen (but not too much!) For Health: Liquid fertiliser products containing seaweed/kelp and other products that are high in potassium (K) help to increase root growth and strengthen your lawn! Thse can be used year-round but help with dormancy.
Plant Growth Regulator	Primo Maxx or QualiPro Marvel
Pre-Emergent Herbicide	Spartan or Barricade (Barricade can also be used on garden beds to prevent weeds)
Preventative Insecticide	Acelepryn - comes in granular or liquid form and is effective either way.
Broadleaf Selective Herbicide	 Bow & Arrow, Spearhead, Estate - Always check to see what herbicides are compatible with your lawn variety. These aren't mentioned inthe planner but can be used safely all-year-round, but should only be used when broadleaf weeds are present - this isn't a preventative measure.
Soil Wetter	 There are a number of wetting agents available on the market. Look for one that states it can be used to improve water penetration in the soil. They can come in granular or liquid form.



GENERAL TIPS

Once your lawn is established, aim to water two to three times per week (twice is ideal) for a longer period of time. A good but less frequent soaking will help develop a deeper root system, making your lawn more drought tolerant!

Mow your lawn regularly once to twice per week in
the summer months is
best! This is the key to a
weed-free and healthy
lawn.

Don't fertilise your lawn if it's sleeping over winter, wait until spring when tyhe nutrients can be taken in!
