Weekday Summer Adventure Weekly Units of Study

Week 1: June 13-17

We love our pets!

Our pets. Whether it's a dog, a cat, a bird, a lizard, or a horse, for many children, the family pet can become their best friend—a companion who not only provides unconditional love, but who also teaches them about friendship, responsibility, loyalty, and empathy. As they engage in sharing and caring activities, games, songs, rhymes, literature, and snacks we've created for our special pets unit, children will learn which animals will make good pets and that all pets need love, care, food, and shelter. Pets also introduce children to the life cycle in a relevant and meaningful way.

Week 2: June 20-24

Jungle Safari

Oh, my! Tigers, elephants, and monkeys! Jump on board this week to take an exciting tour through the jungle to learn about these and other jungle animals, as well as many types of jungle plants. Your children will move like jungle animals, learn jungle animal names, create jungle murals, and play jungle-themed learning games. Get ready to begin your jungle adventure.

Week 3: July 5-8

Ahoy Matey's: It's a pirate's life for me!

Ahoy Matey! Are you ready to walk the plank? Maybe designing your own tiara is more your style? Treasure hunts, eye patches, crowns and so much more! Fantasy, dress-up, stories, art and the 'Queen's Ball'. This week is sure to have it all!

Week 4: July 11-15

A Bugs Life

Meet the creatures that represent almost 90% of animal life on Earth! We will explore the amazing world of insects - Insect life cycles and metamorphosis, and the importance of insects to our daily lives, are all covered too. Get ready to see and make some bugs and creepy crawlers.

Week 5: July 18-22

Not a Box...Or a Stick

This unit of study proves that a stick is not always just a stick. Whether it's conducting an orchestra, painting a masterpiece, or slaying a dragon—give a child a stick and let imagination take over and the magic begin. When the imagination takes over inside a cardboard box, and through play, a child is transported to a world where anything is possible.

Week 6: July 25-29

Super Hero In Training

Get ready for an adventure of heroic proportions while learning to be a superhero! Your heroes get strong and mighty in the gym, and build super-smarts exploring science experiments. Campers design their own super-logos, masks, and more to create the perfect superhero secret identity. Non-stop, action-packed fun for all! (Children are welcome to dress in their favorite Superhero costumes!) Superman, Spiderman, Wonder Woman, Batman, Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles... Don't forget your capes and masks this week because we'll be flying around fighting crime and using our super cool powers.

Week 7: August 1-5

Ooey Gooley, Icky and Sticky

A fun unit of study for budding scientists who like trying a lot of experiments and who don't mind a little mess! We use all sorts of ingredients to mix, measure, combine and react in different ways. Our favorite projects include anything that goes fizz, glop, bubble, or pop! We get ooey, gooley and slimy. Our goal is to experiment in science creatively, without worrying about a right answer — but with a focus on learning and fun. We will get messy and have fun while learning all about science.
