## Weekday Summer Adventure Weekly Units of Study

### **Week 1-June 12-16: Let's Build**

Calling on all budding engineers! Get your hard hats and safety vests on and get ready to build! Blocks, boxes, wood, sandpaper, glue and more! Sanding, screwing, hammering and gluing will be part of our days' work. Paint will be on our hands, glue on our fingers. Strap on your tool belts and come dressed for messy play! We will build something new each day!! If you like to build things, this week is for you. We will challenge your child's creative side utilizing Legos, Magnet tiles, wooden blocks of all shapes and sizes, bristle blocks, toothpicks, straws and marshmallows, and more!

### **Week 2- June 19-23: Wheels and Wings**

Oh, the places you'll go! Children explore the many ways people move from one place to another in this fun-filled week. Concepts of motion, gravity, shape, weight, size and more will be shared as we examine transportation and travel. Activities will be hands on, use children's imagination, and grow their knowledge about all things on the go!

### **Week 3- July 5-7: Color Outside the Lines**

Enjoy the science of the rainbow as we mix up our own colorful palette. Chalk, paint, markers, crayons and more....we will create art and experiment with colors all week. We will have a color run and tie dye our Weekday shirts!

### **Week 4- July 10-14: Zoom, Zoom Off to the Moon**

Blast off into space for this out of this world week that will be full of adventure. Constellations, the moon and planets will be explored. We might even encounter a few friendly aliens. Hop on the space shuttle and get ready for an out of this world experience.

### **Week 5- July 17-21: Just Beachy!**

Where there's an ocean- there's a beach! We will dig deep into what we can find on the beach along the shore! Seashells, seaweed, hermit crabs and more!! We will tie in creatures big and small that live under the Sea. Campers will learn about crabs, turtles, dolphins, angel fish, jelly fish, sharks, swordfish and whales. A special visit from the Maritime Aquarium Touch Tank is included.

### **Week 6- July 24-28: Jurassic Journey**

Can I get a ROAR?? We will be archaeologists as we dig up dinosaurs in our HUGE sand pit! This is the perfect opportunity for future paleontologists to do science in a whole new way. We will focus on dinosaurs and other cool prehistoric creatures. We will explore the prehistoric world dinosaurs lived in, different dinosaur types, dig for fossils and hunt for Dinosaur eggs! Watch out, your child will be ROARING with enthusiasm and knowledge!

### **Week 7- July 31-August 4: Down on the Farm**

What down home fun we will have this week! Using our imaginations we will become farmers! We will learn about farm animals, where they live and what they eat. We will learn about the food we eat, how it grows and even what it takes to make it grow. We might even have a ho down and learn some square dancing! Explore mazes out of hay, pool noodle horses, ring toss and corn hole games. Songs, movement and tactile experiences to keep busy minds and bodies active and engaged!
