Weekday Summer Adventure Weekly Units of Study

Week 1- June 14-19: Just Beachy

Where there's an ocean- there's a beach! We will dig deep into what we can find on the beach along the shore! Seashells, seaweed, hermit crabs and more!! We will tie in creatures big and small that live under the Sea. Campers will learn about crabs, turtles, dolphins, angel fish, jelly fish, sharks, swordfish and whales

Week 2- June 22-26: Play with Color

Enjoy the science of the rainbow as we mix up our own colorful palette. Chalk, paint, markers, crayons and more....we will create art and experiment with colors all week. We will have a color run and tie dye our Weekday shirts!

Week 3- July 6-10: Pet Shop

Summer is the perfect time to celebrate and honor our animal friends; our pets. Whether it's a dog, a cat, a bird, a lizard, or a horse, for many children, the family pet can become their best friend—a companion who not only provides unconditional love, but who also teaches them about friendship, responsibility, loyalty, and empathy. As they engage in sharing and caring activities, games, songs, rhymes, literature, and snacks we've created for our special pets unit, children will learn which animals will make good pets and that all pets need love, care, food, and shelter. Pets also introduce children to the life cycle in a relevant and meaningful way.

Week 4- July 13-17: A Camping we will go

Summer is a time for camping out under the stars, snuggling up in sleeping bags, and roasting marshmallows over a campfire! This week's theme offers a mountain of ideas for bringing the fun of camping into the classroom. Included are activities and games that develop the wonders of nature. So, pitch your tent right here and settle in for an outdoor camping adventure!

Week 5- July 20-24: Wheels and Wings

Oh, the places you'll go! Children explore the many ways people move from one place to another in this fun-filled week. Concepts of motion, gravity, shape, weight, size and more will be shared as we examine transportation and travel. Activities will be hands on, use children's imagination, and grow their knowledge about all things on the go!

Week 6- July 27-31: Ooey Gooey, Icky and Sticky

A fun unit of study for budding scientists who like trying a lot of experiments and who don't mind a little mess! We use all sorts of ingredients to mix, measure, combine and react in different ways. Our favorite projects include anything that goes fizz, glop, bubble, or pop! We get ooey, gooey and slimy. Our goal is to experiment in science creatively, without worrying about a right answer — but with a focus on learning and fun. We will get messy and have fun while learning all about science.

Week 7- August 3-7: Not a Box...Or a Stick

This unit of study proves that a stick is not always just a stick. Whether it's conducting an orchestra, painting a masterpiece, or slaying a dragon—give a child a stick and let imagination take over and the magic begin. When the imagination takes over inside a cardboard box, and through play, a child is transported to a world where anything is possible.
