### **Week 1: June 14-18**

### **Week 2: June 21-25**

We will read many of her books to inspire creativity and encourages children to become the best that they can be! ### **Week 3: July 6-9**

We will focus on dinosaurs and other cool prehistoric creatures. ### **Week 4: July 12-16**
