


Confession and Absolution





Ascribe to the LORD, O families of the peoples, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength!








Psalm







Pastor will light his candle from the Christ candle and then pass the light to the acolytes who will pass the light to the congregation.


(Please Note! <u>Do not tip</u> a lighted candle! Only unlit candles should be tipped to receive light from a burning candle.)


