Continue onto AZ-69 N for 33 miles.

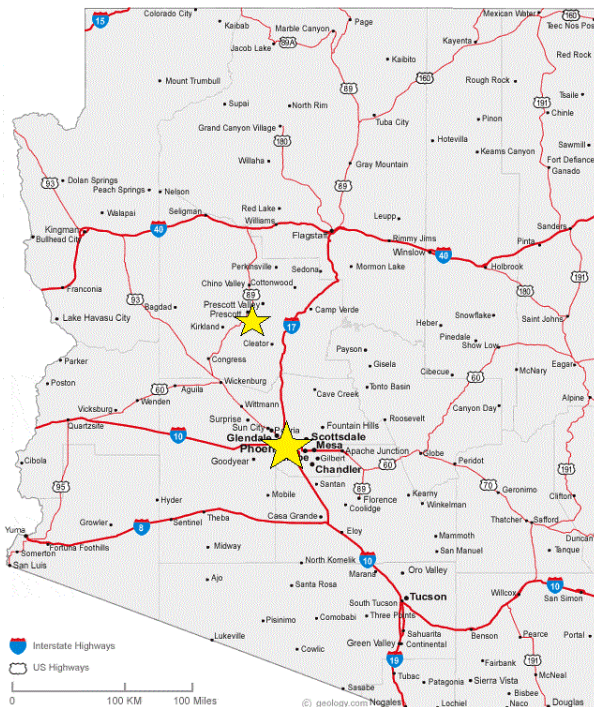
Stay in left lane follow signs toward Gurley St.
