## ***A Note from Pastor Prentice...***

Where has the summer gone? It fly's away so quickly, but we still have some time left to enjoy travel, some golf (or other outside activities), and whatever other family oriented fun. So please, do so and then come back on a Sunday morning to chat about some fun you are having.

So what is your Pastor up to this summer? Yes, I am trying to enjoy God's goodness too. I want to talk about some key times in the Church, a little bit of history that is good for us all, and to try and fill some problem areas that are lacking in care; but I am also pondering some good ideas to help the community we serve. So here goes:

**What is Ordinary Time?** - This is the time when the paraments, the colors go green for a long time. In a nutshell, this is the time following Pentecost, to concentrate and reflect on Jesus and strengthen faith by living the life of Christ. It begins with Trinity Sunday and goes all the way to Christ the King Sunday. Yes, we Lutherans do celebrate some of the great feasts of the church catholic (universal) because they are great teaching moments, markers to reflect upon a faith in Christ. I will try and highlight more of the feasts in our worship, as well in print for your learning.

Ordinary time is when we should grow and mature in our outward expression of faith now that the great seasons and festivals such as Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter are past. It is a time to try and deepen your prayer life, to perhaps read some Scripture in your leisure time (a bit more). It is a time when

we have been told of the gifts of God through the great seasons just mentioned, and we all try and go out to be messengers of that Good News. OK, not easy and that brings me to more thoughts for the future, "how can we do all above?" Of course, continue to come to Church, be in the Word, to partake of the Eucharist (His Body and Blood).

### **Outreach Event(s) -**

01) The Westchester National Night Out - this is an evening where we as a community gather in support of our police department, to build better community relations with them. It is on August 7, the Unity walk begins at our Faith parking lot at 6:30 (we walk down Westchester Blvd. to the Park District). Preparation time is at 6 pm. We plan on having a mission table outside for any and all to learn about Faith (after all, they are using our lot to gather). We need some helpers.

02) I am inviting Cook County Commissioner Boykin to come out and discuss issues in our community. I call this part of Faith Engaging the Community Series, details are to follow in this Newsletter.

03) I am in the planning stages of inviting the K9 Veterans Ministry (LCMS dog ministry to some) to be with us for a time where we share some goodies and chat with veterans and active military in the community. I am looking to do this in the October time frame.

04) Christmas time concert, in the very early phase of, "what would we do?"

**Grief Share / Handling Crisis** - Of late, many of us have experienced loss in various ways, or a crisis, and it is hard to deal with. Telling you, Jesus loves you and prepares a room in heaven for those that departed in the faith is a fact; but does not offer some extra practical advice for us who wait the final days. Having a crisis and saying, Jesus shares in our pain is great, but we also need some extra help along the way. I have been pondering these things and here is at least one that may help (more to come):

- Elmhurst Hospital has a Grief Support Group, and a Coping with Grief Support Group. The new sessions begin this August and are free, just go! I do believe they conclude in January, and then cycle around again.

Grief Support Group - begins August 2, meets the first and third Thursday of every month from 9:30 to 11:00 a.m.; in the Willow Conference Room, the lower level.

Coping with Grief Support Group - begins August 7, meets the first and third Monday of every month from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m.; in the Maple Conference Room, the lower level.

Both groups meet at Elmhurst Hospital, which is at 155 E. Brush Hill Road, Elmhurst Illinois, 60126.

So in conclusion, I am enjoying the summer, yet I hope you can see some of the good things Faith (and your pastor) is trying to do. Remember, God never rests (praise be for that).
