Year C of the Three Year Lectionary Series

(Note) We switched to Lectionary C readings this week. The beginning of the Church year is Advent 1.

Theme for this Day – Sing! Shout! Rejoice! Exult! A string of ecstatic commands infused with an incomparable promise - the Lord has taken away the judgments against you! The Gospel in the flesh of Jesus is at hand. Human anxiousness subsides as God's peace engulfs the hearts, minds, emotions, and wisdom of men. As the reign of Jesus is revealed, we are privileged to witness holy healing, cleansing, resurrecting, and preaching. Christ Jesus alone forgives and redeems us.

Cancelled is the Advent Service for midweek at 7 pm next week - No one came for two weeks, we gave it a shot! We still are planning the midweek at noon.

Cancelled as well is the Seeker Service - We tried for 4 months, no takers. Beginning in 2019, other options may ensue (see the upcoming Newsletter).
