- * Water and gutter issues.
- * Parking lot needs refinishing. We need to work with Park District and Village.
- * We are looking at "perhaps" getting a new church roof; the Insurance Company

is demanding this.

- * Lock on door is not working for church. (it is always in the lock position).
- * Looking for a landscape group to handle the church and parish house properties. Most likely this will occur for next year.
- * Bells do not work; the amplifier appears to be broken.
