Host Ideas

Guest Ideas

- Make sure all of your devices are charged and ready to go, or bring your own charger from home
- Don't block the neighbor's driveway when you park and don't park by a fire hydrant. Safety first!
- Bring something to the host for hosting everyone, drinks, food, stuff like that
- Don't be too loud when you leave, don't want to disturb the neighbors
- Make sure your personal hygiene is in order, uh order.
