

The dandelion Project

Goal:

To fund research into countering climate change and age-related illness through donations. The project will bypass the usual bickering between nations and will distribute the results freely to all participating nations. This ensures we accelerate the development of a clean future.

Method:

1. Countries agree to participate. They do not need to spend any money to do so.
2. The participating countries nominate a number of banks to receive donations.
3. Donors (you) will donate 10c USD (or the equivalent in your local currency) daily.
4. Banks will store these funds for the month, using them temporarily as they see fit.
5. The banks will then send the donations to the Dandelion Project.
It is expected for there to be \$2.88 Billion dollars donated yearly.
6. The Dandelion Project will construct a neutral laboratory with the aid of the UN.
7. The Project will research essential technologies free from politics and conflict.
8. All findings will be distributed, free of charge, to all participating countries.
9. The governments of the participating countries will nominate some industries to receive the manufacturing rights of the research.
10. The world mass produces essential clean energy and medicine.

Who benefits from this?

- Countries gain free technology, profit from the manufacturing rights and reduce their costs associated with treating age-related illness and fossil fuel use.
- Companies may receive the manufacturing rights and profit from the products derived from the research.
- The Environment will suffer less from the burden of fossil fuels and counter-act the accumulated pollution from their use.
- Humans will have access to mass produced medicines, reducing their cost due to competition, as well as the satisfaction of knowing that the average person can change the world without relying on other governments and billion-dollar companies.
