Bi-Monthly Police Report – Sean Cunningham (10 min.)

Crime statistics for the area were reviewed and showed: Burglary/theft in June – we have little reported crime (2-3 incidents per month) no violent crimes/assault and not many calls for service from the area in June. The Sacramento Police Department has launched an <u>Open Data Portal</u> and <u>Community Crime Map</u> which allows public access to retrieve information on call types and volumes as well as police reports filed. Note: information regarding sexual assaults or domestic violence reports will not be displayed due to restrictions on victim information disclosure.

Ice Cream Social Update (Kevin)

The event was held at Sutter Fort Park and was well received with about 25-30 attendees. The Co-op graciously donated all the ice cream for the event. FoCM provided cones, syrups and toppings for the ice cream.

N Street 311 complaints update (Alex)

Alex reached out to Katie Valenzula's office for status on this outstanding complaint. As of June 10^{th} , the City has received and reviewed plans for this project and has been corresponding with the owner. Some corrections were requested by the City. FoCM will continue to monitor the status of this project.

New Business

- National Trust for Historic Preservation grant for historic homes project update (Alex)
 FoCM applied for a grant but did not receive any grant funds. The historic homes project will continue to move forward without additional funding.
