

### MINUTES

# September 9, 2024 - General Meeting 2220 Capitol Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95816

• Call to order: 7:05

- Consent Agenda Athol moved to approve items as presented.
  - O Acceptance of the meeting agenda
  - O Approval of the previous meeting minutes
  - Monthly treasury report
- Bi-Monthly Police Report (10 min.)

Lt. Sean Cunningham reviewed the crime stats for the area noting that essentially there is not too much activity in our area. Four thefts were reported in August and bike thefts appear to be the main target. There were a number of arrests for car break-ins which seem to occur between the hours of 9:00-12:00 p.m. Lt. Cunningham reported that this is "Pedestrian Safety" month and officers are focusing on issuing citations and educating drivers and pedestrians on the rules of the road designed to protect pedestrians. 50 citations were issued for violations. There was a question about how the Police Department prioritizes calls for response/services: Priority 1-2 is for violent offenses; Priority 3-4 is for "crimes in progress". A member of the audience also asked how the Police Department was handling reports of incidents regarding mail theft. Lt. Cunningham indicated that this crime typically falls under the jurisdiction of USPS. Mikayla indicated that this issue has been raised with the City as well and the following information/referral sources were provided: General Mailbox Information: Mail Theft (usps.com)

Once mail theft occurs, the person fills this out as soon as possible so USPS can start fixing the issue: Identity Theft Complaint (uspis.gov)

Mikayla also reported that a feasibility study and preliminary engineering for the <u>Two Rivers Trail Project</u> Phase III is underway. The feasibility study will inform the design that completes the Two Rivers Trail system. Phase III will extend the trail within Sutter's Landing Park at 28th Street west, approximately one mile, to a loop around the Old City Landfill, just east of the Union Pacific

Railroad (UPRR) tracks. West of the UPRR tracks, the trail will connect to the Sacramento Northern Trail and continue west to join the Phase I Trail. The project will also explore alternatives to cross UPRR and State Route 160 to connect with the Two Rivers Trail Phase I project. Environmental clearance, design and construction of the UPRR and State Route 160 crossings will likely be addressed in a future project. The conversion of 5<sup>th</sup> Street from a one-way street to a two-way street from Broadway to the Railyards will be completed by the end of the month. Mikayala reported that the work at the Southside Park pool did not get completed so the pool did not open this summer. Hopefully the work can be completed before next summer.

#### • 311 complaints – Process/update (Alex)

FoCM has advised members to use 311 to register the complaint and has attempted to monitor/follow up with 311 on behalf of the member. Alex found that when complaints have been reviewed and triaged by the 311, the City's spreadsheet will note the complaint as "resolved". Unfortunately, "resolved" only means that the complaint has been reviewed and forwarded to the appropriate agency/unit for resolution. FOCM/Alex can't follow up on the 311 complaint beyond that as we aren't the initiator of the complaint, but she will keep a spreadsheet to track the initial complaint.
