The STANDARD HEAT of The QUADRUPED® consists of 4 dogs, 3 rounds, long distance elimination

 $\mbox{Divisions}$ – There are 4 Divisions for The Quadruped, Novice Mens & Womens , Open Mens & Womens


A Regulation round consists of 3 throws for each team involved.

A Heat consists of 3 regulation rounds for the teams involved in each Division. Last Chance Heat – is just ONE ROUND in length. The Team with the longest catch in the LAST CHANCE HEAT also makes the Finals Finale The last heat in a division with the 4 teams that qualify to compute for

Finals - The last heat in a division with the 4 teams that qualify to compete for the positions of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place.

CDA Competition Rules

CONDITIONS

Competition to be held under the Rules and Regulations of Canine Disc Australia (judging/scoring details for all events will be announced by the judge prior to the Event). and must adhere to the General Ground Rules of the Maximum Air Disc Dogs Inc...
All dogs and handlers must be a member with CDA.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry. Any dog who has had contact with an infectious disease (except kennel cough), will be excluded from any CDA event for 18 days post contact. If a dog on club grounds is established as having an infectious disease (except kennel cough), then all dogs on the ground are excluded from CDA events for 18 days.

Any dog who has kennel cough, or is in the same household as a dog known to have Kennel Cough is excluded from any CDA sanctioned event for 21 days from the onset of clinical signs of kennel cough...
