CONDITIONS

Competition to be held under the Rules and Regulations of Canine Disc Australia (Judging/scoring details for all events will be announced by the Judge prior to the Event). and must adhere to the General Ground Rules of the Canine Disc Australia LTD...

All dogs and handlers must be a member with CDA.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry. Any dog who has had contact with an infectious disease (except kennel cough), will be excluded from any CDA event for 18 days post contact. If a dog on club grounds is established as having an infectious disease (except kennel cough), then all dogs on the ground are excluded from CDA events for 18 days.

Any dog who has kennel cough, or is in the same household as a dog known to have Kennel Cough is excluded from any CDA sanctioned event for 21 days from the onset of clinical signs of kennel cough...

TOP DOG CHALLENGE

A Special Award will be awarded to the dog that competes in all 3 formats of competition (Throw & Catch, Freestyle Skills & Games), across both the Disc Dog Major Challenge & Wind Warriors Canine Disc Championships, earning points towards the overall prize of being crowned Top Dog in one of three Categories, Top Dog Junior Challenge, Top Dog Minor Challenge or Top Dog Major Challenge. By entering all 3 formats automatically enters you into the Top Dog Challenge.

Top Dog Junior Challenge

All Teams competing in all of the following events will be eligible to be crowned Top Junior Dog,

All Events (excluding Long Distance) Providing Handler is eligible for Junior Handler Classification.

Points will be calculated from your Top 4 rounds of Throw & Catch, Top 2 Rounds of Freestyle Skills, & Top 2 Games. Giving teams a Mulligan round in each format

Top Dog Minor Challenge

All Teams competing in all of the following events will be eligible to be crowned Top Minor Dog,

Throw & Catch – Beginner & Excellent Divisions

Freestyle Skills – Pro Division

All Games – excluding Long Distance

Points will be calculated from your Top 4 rounds of Throw & Catch, Top 2 Rounds of Freestyle Skills, & Top 2 Games. Giving teams a Mulligan round in each format

Top Dog Major Challenge

All Teams competing in all of the following events will be eligible to be crowned Top Minor Dog,

Throw & Catch – Open & Master Divisions

Freestyle Skills – Super Pro Division

All Games

Points will be calculated from your Top 4 rounds of Throw & Catch, Top 2 Rounds of Freestyle Skills, & Top 3 Games. Giving teams a Mulligan round in each format

Points Scoring

The following will be used to determine who will be crowned Top Dog.

Points earned will be determined based on the number of competitors and the placing you received after each round.

For eg if there are 11 Competing teams entered in the Top Dog Minor Challenge, Teams will earn the following points for each round/game . 1st Place will receive 11 points, 2nd place 10 points, 3rd place, 4th 9 points, 5th place 8 points and so on with 11th place receiving 1 point.

If places are tied then the points will be split between the tied teams, for eg the 5th & 6th team are tied for 5th Place then they will both receive 7.5 points each calculated as 5th Place receives 8 points, 6th place 7 points which total 15points this is split between the 2 places so each team receives 7.5 points. 7th place receives 6 points.

You will also earn 5 bonus points for each round where you also receive a Qualification card. Bonus points can be doubled by receiving a Qualification card in all rounds of competition.
