## Judging Criteria:

Judging will happen by the submission of one video per team to the Facebook event page (Toadally Freestylin) for judging.

Up to 2 1/2 minutes of unedited or live video will be required per Super Pro Skills team per round to be judged.

Up to 2 min of unedited or live video will be required per Pro Skills Div team per round to be judged.

It is recommended you use the countdown timer which can be downloaded from the CDA website, to verify judging rounds if the countdown cannot be heard on the video the online judge will commence time when a disc is in flight.

Throws caught outside of frame will not be counted.

If your video is poor quality or too far away, TOADS reserves the right to deem it not suitable for judging.

**Prizes:** No prizes. Scores will be determined if minimum criteria have been met for Qualification purposes only.
