This was our first night where the audience was completely silent following Karnak's death and during the Jane Doe Video (both of which were positive versions of silence, I promise, we could hear the tears being shed). We had a great run tonight despite some line and cue flubs, and overall the show still remains very solid! General Notes

- Run Time: 1:28:01
- Head Count: 133
- We think there was an issue with one of the scanners not being connected to the WiFi, because there were definitely more people in the house than notated by the scan count.
- The show was filmed today.

Issues/Repairs

- We got the Asteria mic working today! We aren't exactly sure how, but we did end up using Asteria mics today.
- The curtain was still getting caught like crazy today, but we did not have any stagehands visible being shadow during the run!
- The money was thrown off the vaudeville stage during Noel's Lament.
- There was a lyric flub in Space Age Bachelor Man on "I am just a man, a space age man...", but August paused and picked it up on "As we make love tonight."
- The umbrella turn on was not in sync today, none of the umbrellas had both battery packs turn on, and one umbrella came on roughly 10 seconds late.
- An umbrella went down on Lucy's head during The Ballad of Jane Doe today.

Accidents/Injuries

- Nothing at this time, thank you!

Miscellaneous

- The understudies sound more cohesive when on one mic backstage, so we used one handheld backstage for when the understudies were sweeteners, and then used their mics for Space Age Bachelor Man.
- We added a projection cue to What the World Needs so that the projections are more in sync.

Missed Cues

- SR curtain close following Up With People was late.
- Music beginning for What the World Needs was late.
- LX 302 called early.
- Missed guitar cue for the beginning of Talia, so the piano picked it up until the guitar came in.
- We somehow ended up one cue behind in Ricky's Bumper. It was quickly resolved.
- LX 850 (bows) fired before go was given.
- Music began late for bows.
- The T-shirt projection cue did not fire when go was given. We think it is an issue with the program used for projections. Andy will be looking at it for tomorrow.
